**GENERAL INFORMATION:** This product produces a clear, sparkling yellow solution for cleaning duties when mixed with water. Use this product concentrate in sick rooms, nurseries, and deodorizing. This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high level disinfectant on any surface of the body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body. Do not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. Do not use on date critical or semi-critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high level disinfection.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMAN HEALTH:** May cause eye and skin irritation. Avoid contact of product with eyes or skin. This will provide excellent deodorizing. **For Carpets:** Spray a 1:15 solution on carpets as a good deodorant and anti-static agent. **Hospitals and Sick Rooms:** Use 5 ounces per gallon of water for thorough disinfection. **For Carpets:** Spray a 1:15 solution on carpets as a good deodorant and anti-static agent. Do not use as a terminal disinfectant for carpeting.

**STORAGE & DISPOSAL:** **STORAGE:** Do not expose product to temperatures below 32°F. Store in a locked storage area. Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate other products. **DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved facility. Do not mix with other waste.
