Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

Under "First Aid," add the statements, *"If Swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person."*

General Comments

A stamped copy of the labeling accepted with conditions is enclosed. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed label before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.



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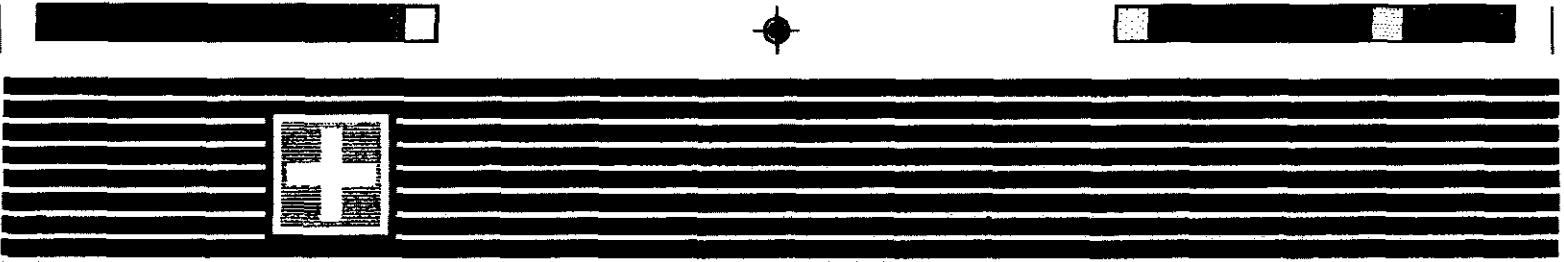

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Clear Lemon 10 Disinfectant

GENERAL INFORMATION: This product produces a clear, sparkling yellow solution that brings the delightful fragrance of fresh lemons to your cleaning duties when mixed with water. Use this product concentrate in sick rooms, nurseries, restaurants and hotels for general disinfecting and deodorizing.

This product is not to be used as a terminal disinfectant on any surface or instrument that (1) is introduced directly into the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes but which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product may be used to pre-clean or decontaminate critical or semi-critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high level disinfection.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
DANGER: Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear chemical goggles, protective clothing, and rubber gloves. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

FIRST AID STATEMENT: IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. Here is the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not contaminate water by the cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewerage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product should be used at regular intervals to deodorize, sanitize and disinfect floors, lavatories, urinals, walls, telephones, furniture, garbage pails, refrigerators, diaper pails, lockers and similar articles and areas that need cleaning, sanitizing or deodorizing. To preserve the good deodorizing properties of this product, do not mix with other soaps or disinfectants.

General Disinfecting: Mix 3 ounces of product to each gallon of water for general disinfecting of Showers, Bathrooms, Garbage and Diaper Pails, Floors, Animal Quarters, Nurseries, Kitchens, Locker Rooms, Lavatories and other areas in need of sanitizing and deodorizing. **Deodorizing:** Add 1 to 2 ounces of product per gallon of mix water. This will provide excellent deodorizing to areas where damp mopping is done. Add 2 ounces of product per gallon of water in a rinse or soak cycle of washer to deodorize diapers and work clothes. **Hospitals and Sick Rooms:** Use 5 ounces per gallon of water for thorough disinfection. Allow surfaces to remain wet for at least 10

minutes. For Carpets: Spray a 1:15 solution on carpets as a good deodorant and anti-static agent. This helps to control mildew and other odor causing molds, used as this dilution. It is not intended as a terminal disinfectant for carpeting. **Food Processing Premises:** Before using this product, food products and packaging materials must be removed from area or carefully protected. After use, all surfaces in the area must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water. Floors, walls and storage areas, add 3 ounces of this product to 5 gallons (0.50 ounces per gallon) of water for equivalent use dilution (450 ppm active quat). For heavily soiled areas, a pre-cleaning step is required. Apply solution with a mop, cloth, sponge or hand pump trigger sprayer so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly. For sprayer application, use a coarse spray. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes, then remove excess liquid. **Animal Care Facilities:** Remove all animals and feeds from premises vehicles and enclosures such as cages and crates. Remove all litter, droppings and manure from boots, walls and surfaces of barns, pens, stalls, chutes and other facilities and fixtures occupied or traversed by animals. Empty all troughs, racks and other feeding and watering appliances. Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water. Use 3 ounces of this product per 5 gallons of water (or equivalent use dilution) (450 ppm active quat). Saturate surfaces with the recommended disinfecting solution for 10 minutes. Immerse all tubs, ropes and other types of equipment used in handling and restraining animals, as well as forks, shovels and scrapers used for removing litter and manure. Ventilate buildings, coops and other closed spaces. Do not house animals or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried. Thoroughly scrub all treated feed racks, mangers, troughs, automatic feeders, burnsties and waterers with soap and detergent and rinse with a potable rinse.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: (Containers 1 gallon or less): Do not expose to temperature extremes. Keep this product in original shipping container under locked storage inaccessible to children or persons unfamiliar with its proper use. Do not reuse container. Discard in trash. (Containers greater than 1 gallon): Do not contaminate food, water, or feed by storage or disposal. **PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Do not expose product to temperature extremes. Keep this product in original shipping container under locked storage inaccessible to children or persons unfamiliar with its proper use. Open dumping is prohibited. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray, or residue in a violation of Federal Law is a violation of Federal law to be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representatives at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse empty container with water. Offer for recycling or reconditioning or purchase and dispose of in a sanitary landfill. If allowed by local authorities, by burning, stay out of smoke.
