### PINE OIL DISINFECTANT

#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**FLOORS, WALLS, WOODWORK:** Solution may be used to disinfect surfaces that are hard, inanimate, and non-porous. Pre-clean surface with an appropriate detergent, rinse and wipe dry.
