 Submission dated May 27, 1992

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Submit one (1) copy of the finished labeling prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. Submit a current Confidential Statement of Formula which includes all of the pertinent information, including the upper and lower certified limits, the bulk density of the product, and the flashpoint/flame extension.
2. The pesticide product referenced above was not located in the List of Proprietary Substances and Nonfood Compounds Authorized for use under USDA Inspection and Grading Programs. Delete the statement "Authorized by USDA for use in federally inspected meat and poultry plants", or submit verification that this product has been approved by USDA for use in the federally inspected food processing plants.
3. Add the following text to the **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS** section of the product label: In hospitals, remove patients prior to treatment. Ventilate area for two hours prior to returning patients.

- 4. In the ingredients statement, the term "Inert Ingredients" should be of the same type size and aligned to the same margin as the term "ACTIVE INGREDIENTS".
- 5. In the paragraph which begins "Do not apply directly to food. In commercial...", revise the statement "After treatment, all surfaces where exposed food will be handled must be washed and rinsed with potable water prior to use" as follows:

In food processing facilities, all benches, shelving, food contact surfaces, utensils, etc., must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse prior to use.

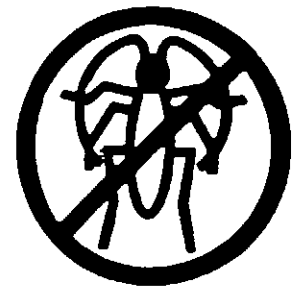
