Since this product contains petroleum distillates, change the First Aid Statement for If Swallowed to read:


IF SWALLOWED:

- * Immediately call a poison control center or doctor.
- * Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor.
- * Do not give any liquid to the person.
- * Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS
AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:**

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

FIRST AID STATEMENT: IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Contains petroleum distillates - vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not contaminate water by the cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: This formula is combustible. Keep container sealed. Do not use, pour, spill, or store near heat or open flame.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Use a good insecticide sprayer designed specifically for insecticides. Spray into space to kill other small flying insects. Spray surfaces to kill certain other crawling insects. Follow directions carefully for best results. Do not apply directly to food. In food processing facilities, all benches, shelving, food contact surfaces, utensils, etc., must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse prior to use.
