Dear Ms. Watson:

The amended label for EPA Reg. 10807-99/ Misty WK 44 Liquid Weed Killer is acceptable provided you make the following changes to the label:

1. The "First Aid" section should be placed within a box. The "First Aid" section should be broken up to resemble the suggested label outline on the attached page.
2. Add "exist" after "washables" on page 2 of the label.
3. A "PPE" section must be added to the label.
4. A "Non-Agricultural Use Requirements" section must be added to the label.
5. To the "Storage and Disposal" section change "Storage" to "Pesticide Storage". Directly under the "Storage and Disposal" heading and before the heading "Pesticide Storage" add "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal." and remove "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal." from under the heading "Pesticide Storage".

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Applicators and other handlers must wear: - Chemical resistant gloves, - long sleeved shirt and long pants, - shoes plus socks. Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washable, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

USER SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS: Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Users should remove PPE immediately after handling this product. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing.

FIRST AID STATEMENT: IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when cleaning equipment or disposing of equipment washwaters.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

General Instructions: This product is a liquid non-selective, general herbicide which is designed to be used where control of all vegetation is desired. Translocation and root absorption produce extensive root kill of weeds and provides long term control. For easy application and better penetration dilute one gallon of this product to 10 gallons of water and apply as directed below. Sufficient moisture from rainfall or artificial means is necessary after treatment to carry the chemical into the root of the weeds. This product is recommended for non-crop areas such as RAILROADS, HIGHWAYS, PIPELINES, TANK FARMS, LUMBER YARDS, FENCE ROWS and PARKING LOTS. This product can be sprayed or sprinkled on. If sprayed, direct the spray to the soil at the base of the weeds and adjust for coarse spray to prevent drifting. Thoroughly clean spray equipment with a suitable chemical cleaner before using for other purposes or do not use same spray equipment for other purposes.

Annual Weeds and Grass: Such as Crabgrass, Foxtail, Ryegrass, Wild Oats, Ragweed, Broomgrass, Lambsquarter, and similar weeds. Use 10 gallons of the diluted product per 750 sq. ft. (400 to 600 gal./acre). Limit application to one retreatment per year.

Perennial Weeds and Grasses: Such as Smooth Brome, Quackgrass, Bluegrass, Purple Top, Dandelion, Goldenrod, Wild Carrot, and similar weeds. Use 10 gallons of the diluted product per 400 sq. ft. (900 to 1,000 gal./acre). Limit application to one retreatment per year.

Retreatment: Apply 10 gallons of the diluted product per 750 sq. ft. when Annual Weeds and Grasses reappear. Limit application to one retreatment per year.

GENERAL PRECAUTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS: For use on plants in non-crop and non-timber areas only. Not for use on crops, timber, or other plants being grown for sale or other commercial use, or for commercial seed production, or research purposes. Not to be used to treat ditches and/or ditch banks. Not to be used in any recreational areas or in or around homes. Do not enter or allow others to enter the treated areas until sprays have dried. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Do not apply this product on or near desirable plants or to areas where roots of desirable plants may come into contact with it. Do not use on lawns, walks, driveways, or tennis courts or similar areas. Do not apply to frozen ground. Avoid spray drift. Do not contaminate domestic water or irrigation water. Note: Maximum application is 1,320 gallons of diluted product (120 gallons of product providing 12 lbs. of bromacil) per acre per year.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: **STORAGE:** Do not expose product to temperature extremes. Store product in original shipping container in a locked storage area. Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. In the event of a spill or leak, contain product with a dry absorbent and dispose of in accordance with state or local regulations. Wear protective clothing during cleanup procedures. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL: IF EMPTY:** Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **IF PARTLY FILLED:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
