For Crawling Insects such as ROACHES, EARWIGS, CRICKETS, and CENTIPEDES: Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, openings, and under objects. For ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry.

STORAGE and DISPOSAL

Storage: Do not expose product to heat, spark or open flame. Store container in a cool, dry place. Store product in original shipping container in a locked storage area. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide Disposal: Dispose of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
