All food processing surfaces, benches, shelving, etc. should be covered or removed during treatment or thoroughly washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse prior to use. In hospitals, patients should be removed from room prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated for 2 hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

For HOUSEFLIES: Close windows. Paint the room. Inspect insects. Fill the room closed for at least 24 hours. Complete. WASP: Insects are at contact as in Crawling Insects. SOW BUGS, SPIDERS: In places such as areas. Spray doors and points of entrance.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store food or feed by this product. To heal, spark or expose product. Shipping container not in use. PESTICIDE product may be facility. In the event and dispose of protective clothing. POSAL: Triple rinsing, or puncture procedures apply.
