### CLEAR-MINT 10

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** This product makes a clear, sparkling green solution when mixed with water for your cleaning duties. Use in sick rooms, nurseries, restaurants, hospitals, nursing homes, animal kennels, general disinfecting of washable surfaces. This product is very effective when used at regular intervals in urinals, lavatories, telephones and similar surfaces and areas in need of sanitizing and cleaning. This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high level disinfectant on any surface or instrument either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intended to penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product may be used on critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high level disinfection.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:** Harmful if swallowed. Causes eye and skin irritation. Avoid contact of product with eyes or mucous membranes. Avoid contact with skin. Wash hands thoroughly after use. Avoid breathing dusts or mists. Avoid contact with clothing. Avoid contact with food or handling facilities. All surfaces, equipment and utensils must be removed, covered or thoroughly cleaned.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:**  
**SKIN CONTACT:** Wash affected area with soap and water. **EYE CONTACT:** Flush with plenty of clean water for large volumes of water or egg whites beaten with water. Consult physician.  
**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This product is toxic to fish. Treated effluent should not be discharged into streams, rivers, lakes, ponds, streams, or other bodies of water. This product should be used on floors, lavatories, urinals, walls, telephones, furniture, garbage pails, refrigerators, diaper pails, lockers, etc. The deodorizing properties of this product do not mix it with other soaps or disinfectants.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label. Use 3 ounces of product per gallon of water. At this dilution rate, the solution will be effective against Staphylococcus aureus and Salmonella choleraesuis. This has been substantiated by the A.O.A.C. Use Dilution Method. For General Disinfection: Apply solution with cloth, sponge or mop. Allow surface to remain wet for 10 minutes. Walls which are treated with this product must be rinsed with potable water prior to re-use. At a rate of 3 ounces per gallon, this product is effective against pathogenic fungus such as Trichophyton interdigitale. Use of this product to disinfect rooms, lockers, gyms, spas and similar areas is advised. For heavy soils or organic matter, a pre-cleaning is recommended.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: STORAGE:** Do not expose product to temperature extremes. Store in a locked storage area. Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food or feed. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. Do not mix with other chemicals. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling, reconditioning or puncture and disposal as a solid waste. Do not reuse container. Follow applicable state and local authorities.
