The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with comments:

Response to PR Notice 2001-1

LABEL COMMENTS

- Expand the Disinfecting directions to add the following "Food Processing Premises": Before using this product, food products and packaging materials must be removed from area or carefully protected. After use, all surfaces in the area must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water. Floors, walls and storage areas, add 3 ounces of this product to 5 gallons (0.60 ounces per gallon) of water (or equivalent use dilution) (450 ppm active quat). For heavily soiled areas, a pre-cleaning step is required. Apply solution with a mop, cloth, sponge or hand pump trigger sprayer so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly. For sprayer application, use a coarse spray. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes, then remove excess liquid.
- Add the following directions for "Animal Care Facilities": Remove all animals and feeds from premises vehicles and enclosures such as coops and crates. Remove all litter, droppings and manure from floors, walls and surfaces of barns, pens, stalls, chutes and other facilities and fixtures occupied or traversed by animals. Empty all troughs, racks and other feeding and watering appliances. Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water. Use 3 ounces of this product per 5 gallons of water (or equivalent use dilution) (450 ppm active quat). Saturate surfaces with the recommended disinfecting solution for 10 minutes. Immerse all halters, ropes and other types of equipment used in handling and restraining animals, as well as forks, shovels and scrapers used for removing litter and manure. Ventilate buildings, coops and other closed

spaces. Do not house animals or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried. Thoroughly scrub all treated feed racks, mangers, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains and waterers with soap or detergent and rinse with a potable rinse.


- 3. You must submit separate deodorizing directions.
- 4. Under the "Directions For Use" delete the claim "refrigerators" from the label.

GENERAL INFORMATION: This product makes a clear, sparkling green solution when mixed with water that brings the delightful fragrance of wintergreen to your cleaning duties. Use in sick rooms, nurseries, restaurants, hospitals, nursing homes, animal care facilities and similar areas for deodorizing and general disinfecting of washable surfaces. This product is very effective when used at regular intervals to deodorize, sanitize and disinfect floors, walls, urinals, lavatories, telephones and similar surfaces and areas in need of sanitizing and cleaning.

This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high level disinfectant on any surface or instrument that (1) is introduced directly into the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes but which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product may be used to pre-clean or decontaminate critical or semi-critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high level disinfection.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

WARNING: Harmful if swallowed. Causes eye and skin irritation. Avoid contact of product with eyes or skin. Avoid contamination of food. In food processing or handling facilities, all surfaces, equipment and utensils must be removed, covered or thoroughly rinsed prior to re-use.

FIRST AID STATEMENT: IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **IF IN EYES:** Hold eyes open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eyes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not contaminate water by the cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product should be used at regular intervals to deodorize, sanitize and disinfect floors, lavatories, urinals, walls, telephones, furniture, garbage pails, refrigerators, diaper pails, lockers and similar articles and areas. To preserve the good deodorizing properties of this product, do not mix it with other soaps or disinfectants. Use 3 ounces of product per gallon of water. At this dilution rate, the solution will be effective against

Pseudomonas aeruginosa PDR-10, *Staphylococcus aureus* and *Salmonella choleraesuis*. This has been substantiated by the A.O.A.C. Use Dilution Method.

General Disinfections: Apply solution with cloth, sponge or mop. Allow surface to remain wet for 10 minutes. Food processing surfaces, utensils, floors and walls which are treated with this product must be rinsed with potable water prior to re-use. At a rate of 6 1/2 ounces of product per gallon of water, the product is effective against pathogenic fungus such as *Trichophyton mentagrophytes*. Use of this product to prevent and control athlete's foot in showers, dressing rooms, lockers, gyms, spas and similar areas is advised. For heavy soils or organic matter, a pre-cleaning step is required.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: STORAGE: Do not expose product to temperature extremes. Store product in original shipping container in a locked storage area. Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. In the event of a spill or leak, contain product with a dry absorbent and dispose of in accordance with state and local regulations. Wear protective clothing during clean up procedures. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL: IF EMPTY:** Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **IF PARTLY FILLED:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
