Dear Ms. Watson,

The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below.

- Response to Agency letter dated October 29, 2003

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1. According to PR Notice 2001-1, the statement, "Have product container or label with you when calling a poison control center, or doctor, or going for treatment advice," must appear in the "First Aid" section either before or after statements.
2. Revise the "General Disinfection" directions to state "Apply solution with cloth, sponge, or mop. Allow surfaces to remain wet for 10 minutes. Allow to air dry or rinse excess solution with clean mop, cloth, or sponge. Rinse all surfaces that come in contact with food such as counters, tables, stovetops with potable water before reuse. Do not use on utensils, glasses, dishes, or cookware. For heavily soiled surfaces, preclean. Prepare a fresh solution daily or more often if the solution becomes visibly diluted or soiled."

You must note that this product must not be used on food contact utensils; this product is not cleared as a food contact sanitizer.

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

GENERAL INFORMATION: This product makes a clear, sparkling green solution when mixed with water that brings the disinfectant properties of its active ingredients to bear on bacteria, viruses, fungi, yeasts, and molds. It is effective on all hard surfaces, animal care facilities and similar areas for deodorizing and general disinfecting of washable surfaces. This product is very effective when used at regular intervals to deodorize, sanitize and disinfect floors, walls, utensils, fixtures, telephones and similar surfaces and areas in need of sanitizing and cleaning.

This product is not to be used as a terminal disinfectant on any surface or instrument that (1) is introduced directly into the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product may be used to pre-clean or decontaminate critical or semi-critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high level disinfection.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

DANGER: Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear chemically resistant, protective clothing, and rubber gloves. Handle if contained or absorbed through the skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

FIRST AID STATEMENTS: IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not get anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not contribute water by the cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product should be used at regular intervals to deodorize, sanitize and disinfect floors, televisions, urinals, walls, telephones, furniture, garbage pails, a diaper pail, lockers and similar articles and areas. To preserve the good deodorizing properties of this product, do not mix it with other soaps or disinfectants.

Use 3 ounces of product per gallon of water. At this dilution rate, the solution will be effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* FDR-10, *Staphylococcus aureus* and *Stenotrophomonas maltophilia*. This has been substantiated by the A.O.A.C. Use Dilution Method.

General Directions: Apply solution with cloth, sponge or mop. Allow solution to remain wet for 10 minutes. Food processing surfaces, utensils, floors and walls which are treated with this product must be rinsed with potable water prior to re-use. At a rate of 1/2 ounce of product per gallon of water, the product is effective against pathogenic fungus such as *Trichophyton mentagrophytes*. Use of this product to prevent and control athlete's foot in humans.

cleaning rooms, lockers, gowns, shoes and similar areas is advised. For heavy soils or organic matter, a pre-cleaning step is required. **Deodorizing:** Add 1 to 2 ounces of product per gallon of water in a rinse or soak cycle of water to areas where damp mopping is done. Add 2 ounces of product per gallon of water in a rinse or soak cycle of water to deodorize floors and work clothes. **Food Processing Premises:** Before using this product, food products and packaging materials must be removed from area or carefully protected. After use, all surfaces in the area must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water. Floors, walls and storage areas, add 3 ounces of this product to 5 gallons (0.60 ounces per gallon) of water (for equivalent use dilution) (450 ppm active quat). For heavily soiled areas, a pre-cleaning step is required. Apply solution with a mop, cloth, sponge or hand pump trigger sprayer so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly. For spore applications, use a coarse spray. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes, then remove excess liquid. **Animal Care Facilities:** Remove all animals from premises, vehicles and enclosures such as coops and crates. Remove all litter, droppings and manure from floors, walls and surfaces of barns, pens, stalls, cribs and other facilities and fixtures occupied or traversed by animals. Empty all troughs, racks and other feeding and watering appliances. Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water. Use 3 ounces of this product per 5 gallons of water (for equivalent use dilution) (450 ppm active quat). Saturate surfaces with the recommended disinfecting solution for 10 minutes. Immerse all halteres, ropes and other types of equipment used in handling and restraining animals, as well as forks, shovels and scrapers used for removing litter and manure. Ventilate buildings, coops and other closed spaces. Do not house animals or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried. Thoroughly scrub all treated feed racks, troughs, trough, automatic feeders, buckets and waterers with soap and detergent and rinse with a potable rinse. **Toilet Bowl/Urinal Disinfection:** Remove gross soil prior to disinfection. Empty toilet bowl or urinal, apply use solution to exposed surfaces including under the rim with cloth, brush, mop, or sprayer. Empty toilet bowl or urinal, exposed surfaces including under the rim. Allow to stand 10 minutes, then flush.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: **Containers 1 gallon or less:** Do not expose to temperature extremes. Keep the product in original shipping container under locked storage inaccessible to children or persons unfamiliar with its proper use. Do not reuse container. Discard in trash. **Containers greater than 1 gallon:** Do not contribute food, water, or feed by storage or disposal. **PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Do not expose product to temperature extremes. Keep this product in original shipping container under locked storage inaccessible to children or persons unfamiliar with its proper use. Open storage is prohibited. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are acutely toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray, or solution is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by the user, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the nearest Regional Office of the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse empty container with water. Offer for recycling or reconditioning or practice and dispose of in a sanitary landfill. If allowed by local authorities, by burning, stay out of smoke.
