**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or veterinarian immediately. Indicated if material is taken internally. Remove or cover exposed food and food handling surfaces. Remove animals, plant life, and other items from the area. Close off room or area to be treated. Extinguish all flames and open flames. Apply 1 1/3 fluid ounces per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Direct nozzle of thermal applicator toward the area to be treated. Close off room for at least 1/2 hour. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area at least 10 minutes before re-entry. **OUTDOORS:** For reduction in annoyance from flies, mosquitoes and gnats in backyards, patios, and other outdoor areas. Hold thermal applicator at least five feet from any object, especially plants and shrubs. Apply 2 gallons of 20% product per acre which is the equivalent of 1 1/3 oz. per 1000 cu. ft. RE-ENTRY: Do not re-enter at least 1/2 hour. Do not remain in treated area. Ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

**STORAGE & DISPOSAL:** **STORAGE:** Do not expose product to heat, fire, or open flame. Do not expose product to temperature extremes. Store product in original shipping container, closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or other procedures approved by state and local authorities. This product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility in accordance with state or local regulations. Wear protective clothing and equipment.
