A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records. Submit 5 copies of the final label prior to releasing the product for marketing.

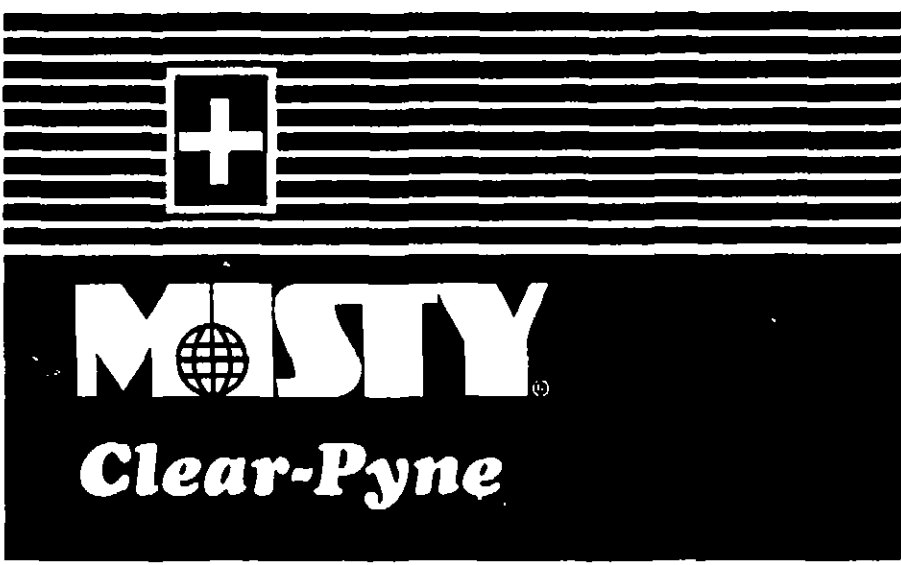

CLEAR-PYNE

This Disinfectant/Deodorant is effective against a wide variety of gram positive and gram negative bacteria, fungi, and viruses. It is an excellent deodorant. This product mixes readily with water and provides a clear, stable solution on painted surfaces, plastics, tiles, glass and most metals. Use for general disinfection in hospitals, shops, hotels and motels, pet care facilities, convention centers, office buildings and other areas. It is ideal for walls, floors, tables, counters, porcelain and tile, plastic and formica surfaces, etc. This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high level disinfectant on any surface or on the body either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. Do not use on critical or semi-critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high level disinfection.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:
CAUTION: Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. If swallowed, Avoid contamination of food or water.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish. Treated effluent should not be discharged into streams, rivers, or public waters.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
For Disinfection: Flush away surface soils with water if possible. Clean surfaces with a solution of 1 ounce of disinfectant per gallon of water. Apply to surface with a mop, cloth, sponge or spray. Agitate if needed and rinse with clear water. For porous surfaces, difficult to clean surfaces, use a solution of 8 ounces of disinfectant with each gallon of water. Apply with sprayer for 10 minutes. Rinse with clear water. Any surface which may have direct or incidental food contact should be deodorized with this solution. Spray or wipe onto thoroughly wet surface, allow to remain wet for 10 minutes, then rinse with clear water.
For Deodorizing: Surfaces and areas subject to objectionable odors may be effectively deodorized with this solution. Spray or wipe onto thoroughly wet surface, allow to remain wet for 10 minutes, then rinse with clear water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: **STORAGE:** Do not expose to temperature extremes. Store in a locked storage area. Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water with this product. **DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved off-site facility. Do not dump or leak, contain product with a dry absorbent and dispose of in accordance with state or local regulations. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reuse, if available, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
