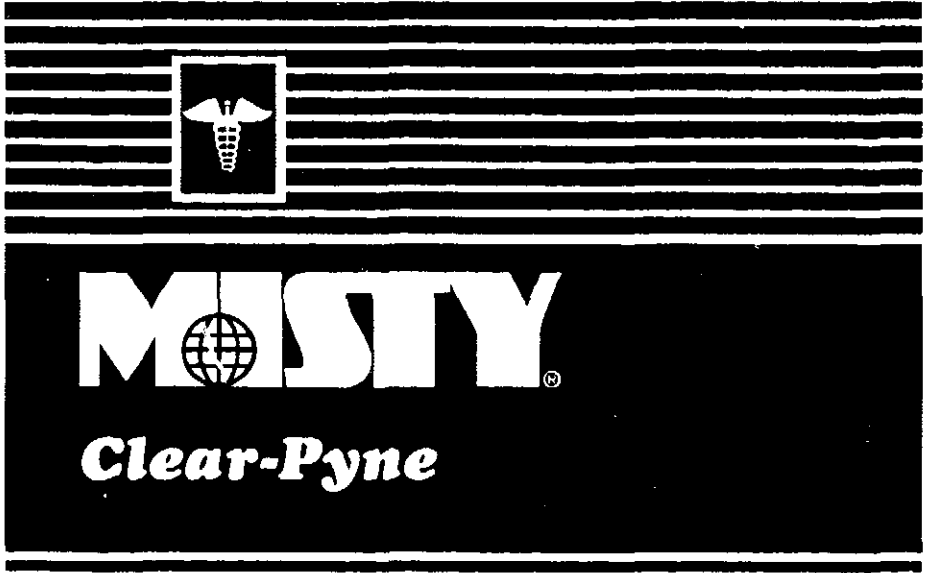

This Disinfectant/Deodorant is effective against a wide variety of gram positive and gram negative bacteria, fungi and viruses. It is an excellent deodorant. This product mixes readily with water and provides a clear, stain-free surface. It is effective against staining on painted surfaces, plastics, tiles, glass and most metals. Use for general disinfection in homes, schools, hospitals, hotels and motels, pet care facilities, convention centers, office buildings, and beauty shops. This product is ideal for walls, floors, tables, counters, porcelain and tile, plastic and wood surfaces.

This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high level disinfectant on any surface of the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. Do not use on critical or semi-critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high level disinfection.

For porous surfaces, difficult to clean, make a disinfecting solution of 8 ounces of disinfectant with each gallon of water. Apply to surface for 10 minutes. Rinse with clear water. Any surface which may have direct contact with potable water.

For Deodorizing: Surfaces and areas subject to objectionable odors may be effectively deodorized with this solution. Spray or wipe onto thoroughly wet surface, allow to remain wet for at least 10 minutes. Rinse with clear water.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: STORAGE: Do not expose to temperature extremes. Store in a locked storage area. Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate other products.

DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved off-site facility.
