The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended per our letter dated March 3, 1995 is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Delete "Concentrated" from front panel.
2. Delete "Use only as directed" from front panel.
3. Revise "See added cautions on side panels", to read "See additional precautions on side panels."
4. Either delete the Environmental Hazards section from the label or revise the statements under Environmental Hazards to read as follows: "This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA."

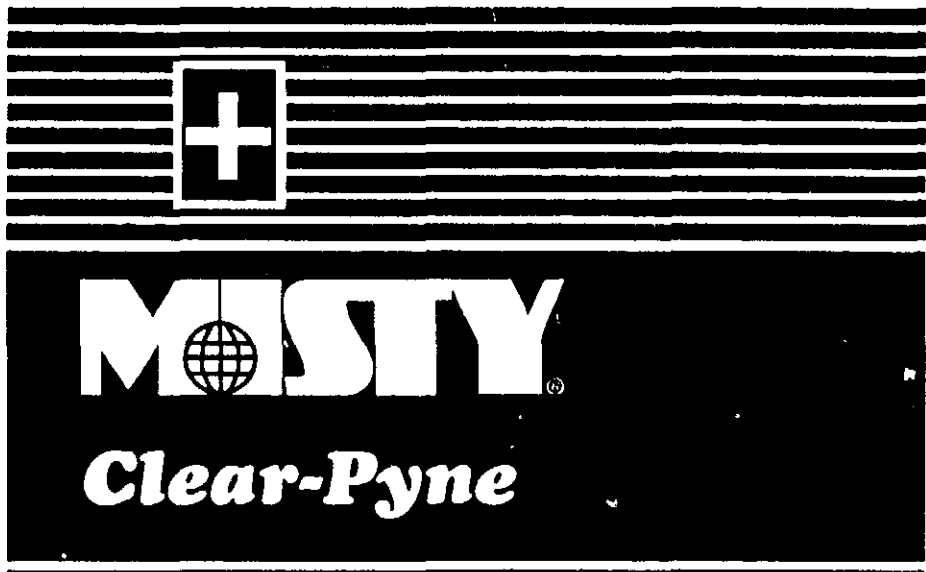

This product mixes readily with water and provides a clear, stable solution. It is non-staining on painted surfaces, plastics, tiles, glass and most metals. Use for general disinfection and deodorizing in homes, schools, hospitals, hotels and motels, pet care facilities, convention centers, office buildings, and beauty shops. This product is ideal for walls, floors, tables, counters, porcelain and tile, plastic and wood surfaces.

This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high level disinfectant on any surface of the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body or decontaminate critical or semi-critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high level disinfection.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label. For Disinfection: Flush away surface soils with water if possible. Clean surfaces with a solution of 8 ounces of disinfectant per gallon of water. Apply to surface with a mop, cloth, sponge or brush. Allow surface to remain wet for at least 10 minutes. Rinse with clear water. For non-porous surfaces, allow to remain wet for 10 minutes. For porous surfaces, difficult to clean surfaces, make a disinfecting solution of 8 ounces of disinfectant with each gallon of water. Apply with a brush or sponge on surface for 10 minutes. Rinse with clear water. Any surface which may have direct or indirect contact with potable water.

For Deodorizing: Surfaces and areas subject to objectionable odors may be effectively deodorized with this solution. Spray or wipe onto thoroughly wet surface, allow to remain wet for 10 minutes. Rinse with clear water.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS: **CAUTION:** Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food or water.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: SKIN CONTACT: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash with plenty of clear water for at least 15 minutes. Contact physician if irritation persists. **EYE CONTACT:** Flush with plenty of clear water for at least 15 minutes. Contact physician if irritation persists. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish. Treated effluent should not be discharged into ponds or public waters.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: STORAGE: Do not expose to temperatures below 32°F. Store in a locked storage area. Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate food or feed. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of by incineration. In the event of a spill or leak, contain product with a dry absorbent and dispose of in accordance with local, state and federal regulations. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent) and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
