The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with comments:

Response to PR Notice 2001-1

LABEL COMMENTS

- In the first paragraph of the label, insert the word "glazed" before porcelain and tile.
- Add the following directions for "Pet Care Facilities": For cleaning and disinfecting the following hard nonporous surfaces: Equipment, utensils, instruments, cages, kennels, stables, stalls and catteries. Remove all animals and feeds from premises, animal transportation vehicles, crates, etc. Remove all litter, droppings and manure from floors, walls and surfaces of facilities occupied or transversed by animals. Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water. Saturate surfaces with a use solution of 2 ounces per gallon of water (or equivalent dilution) (850 ppm active quat) for a period of 10 minutes. Ventilate buildings and other closed spaces. Do not house animals or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried. Thoroughly scrub all treated feed racks, automatic feeders, waterers and other equipment which dispenses food or water with soap or detergent, and rinse with potable water rinse before reuse.
- Add the following directions for "barber and beauty shops: Immerse preclean barber/salon tools (such as combs, brushes, razors, clipper and trimmer blades, tweezers manicure/pedicure tools and scissors) in a 2 ounces per gallon solution of the product (or equivalent use dilution) (850 ppm active quat). Completely immerse instruments and tools for at least 10 minutes. Rinse thoroughly and dry before use. Prepare fresh solution daily or more often if solution becomes cloudy or soiled. NOTE: Plastics may remain


immersed until ready to use. Stainless steel shears and instruments must be removed after 10 minutes, rinsed, dried, and kept in a clean non-contaminated receptacle. Prolonged soaking may cause damage to metal instruments.

This Disinfectant/Deodorant is effective against a wide variety of gram positive and gram negative bacteria and pathogenic fungi. It is also an excellent deodorant. This product mixes readily with water and provides a clear, stable solution. In use dilution it is non-corrosive and non-staining on painted surfaces, plastics, tiles, glass and most metals. Use for general disinfection in hospitals, nursing homes, restaurants, barber and beauty shops, hotels and motels, pet care facilities, convention centers, office buildings and other areas where large groups of people gather. This product is ideal for walls, floors, tables, counters, porcelain and tile, plastic and formica surfaces, telephones, glass and sealed wood surfaces.

This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high level disinfectant on any surface or instrument that (1) is introduced directly into the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes but which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product may be used to pre-clean or decontaminate critical or semi-critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high level disinfection.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Remove and wash contaminated clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food or water.

FIRST AID STATEMENT: IF IN EYES: Hold eyes open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For Disinfection: Flush away surface soils with water if possible. Clean surfaces with a solution of 4 ounces of disinfectant per gallon of water. Allow surface to remain wet for at least 10 minutes. Rinse with clear water. For non-porous, easily cleaned areas, make a disinfecting solution of 6 ounces of disinfectant per gallon of water. Apply to surface with a mop, cloth, sponge or sprayer and allow surface to remain wet for 10 minutes. Agitate if needed and rinse with clear water. For porous surfaces, difficult to clean surfaces or areas of contagious disease potential, make a disinfecting solution of 8 ounces of disinfectant with each gallon of water. Apply with sprayer, sponge, mop, or cloth and allow to remain on surface for 10 minutes. Rinse with clear water. Any surface which may have direct or incidental food contact must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water. **For Deodorizing:** Surfaces and areas subject to objectionable odors may be effectively deodorized with a solution of 16 ounces of disinfectant per gallon of water. Garbage cans, diaper pails, bathrooms, toilets, sinks, shower stalls, locker rooms, grocery stores and similar areas will be effectively deodorized with this solution. Spray or wipe onto thoroughly wet surface, allow to remain wet for 10 minutes, agitate if required and thoroughly rinse with clear water.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: **STORAGE:** Do not expose to temperature extremes. Store product in original shipping container in a locked storage area. Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. In the event of a spill or leak, contain product with a dry absorbent and dispose of in accordance with state or local regulations. Wear protective clothing during clean up procedures. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL: IF EMPTY:** Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **IF PARTLY FILLED:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
