Subject: Amendment - Revised Labeling  
Misty Defense Residual Insecticide  
EPA Registration No. 10807-112  
Your Letters Dated November 19, 1992 and January 5, 1993

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. We have no objection to the additional language added reflecting that the product is ready to use, but it still does not inform the user how to apply the product. Unless the containers have a spray head already affixed to the head of the container enabling the user to apply the product add the following statement beneath the misuse statement under Directions for Use:

Affix trigger, pump or similar type sprayer to container for application. Do not transfer to another container.

2. We note the product label contains some but not all the precautionary statements required via the guidance document for reregistration of products containing diazinon. Thus add the following precautions under the use direction for indoor use:

Do not use this product indoors as an overall surface spray or as a space spray. Take care not to introduce this product into the air during application. Use only in well ventilated areas. Do not apply where children are likely to frequently contact treated surfaces. Remove pets and cover fish bowls before spraying. Do not treat pets or plants with this product. Do not apply when other persons are in the immediate area. Do not allow children or pets in treated areas until spray has dried. If clothing is sprayed during application, remove

clothing immediately after spraying and launder before wearing again. Do not apply directly to carpets or floor coverings and avoid excess wetting of asphalt tile, rubber, and plastic materials because damage may occur. Care should be taken to avoid spotting of walls, wall coverings, and fabrics. Do not apply directly to upholster or furniture. Do not apply to areas, surfaces, or utensils which will contact food or feed. Exposed food should be covered or removed during application. All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during application or thoroughly washed with soap and water before use. Do not use this product in conduits, motor housings, or electrical switch boxes.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician immediately. **DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING UNLESS NO OTHER TREATMENT IS AVAILABLE.** Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting, give victim one or two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth if person is unconscious or convulsing. **IF INHALED:** Remove victim to fresh air and apply artificial respiration if indicated. **IF ON SKIN:** Wash promptly with soap and water. Rinse thoroughly. **IF IN EYES:** Flush with plenty of water and call a physician immediately. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** This product is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine. This product also contains aromatic petroleum derivative solvent which may present an aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage may be indicated if product was taken internally.

#### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is highly toxic to birds, fish, and other wildlife. Birds, feeding or drinking on treated areas may be killed. Keep out of feeding or drinking lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes and estuaries. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by disposal.

This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming plants where they feed. Do not allow this pesticide to drift to blooming plants if bees are visiting the treatment area. Do not apply this product to or allow it to drift to food crops or any desirable vegetation at any time.

#### PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use, pour spill, or store near heat or open flame.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**Re-Entry Statement:** Thoroughly ventilate treated area for one hour prior to re-entry.

**ROACHES, ANTS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, CRICKETS:** Spray heavily into all cracks, around baseboards and other places where these insects hide. Also behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, stoves, etc. Spray other localized areas infested with these pests. Repeat treatment as required.

**CARPET BEETLES:** Spray edges of carpeting and under carpeting and rugs. Make localized application to the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks, crevices and infested areas of shelving. Repeat as necessary.

**BROWN DOG TICKS:** Thoroughly spray sleeping quarters of animals. Spray infested areas around baseboards, windows, door frames and wall coverings. Applications should be repeated as necessary. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not treat animals with formulation.

**FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS and FLYING MOTHS OUTDOORS:** For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages, and other places where these insects might congregates.

**FLEAS, CHIGGERS, ANTS OUTDOORS:** For treatment of localized infestations of these insect in outdoor areas, spray weeds and bushy non-crop areas around the home thoroughly. Avoid spraying desirable plants. For ants, thoroughly wet hills and runways. Repeat applications as infestations warrant and as reinfestations occur.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Do not expose product to heat, spark or open flame. Store container in a cool dry location. Do not expose product to temperature extremes. Store product in original shipping container in a locked storage or disposal.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. In the event of a spill or leak, contain product with a dry absorbent and dispose of in accordance with state or local regulations. Wear protective clothing during clean up procedures.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** For quart containers, do not reuse. Securely wrap in several layers of newspapers and discard in trash. For all other containers, triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
