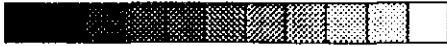

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is highly toxic to birds, fish, and other wildlife. Birds, feeding or nesting, are highly susceptible to direct treatment or residues on blooming plants which bees are visiting the treatment area. Do not apply this product to or allow it to drift to food crops or any desirable plants. Do not apply to water bodies or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of the local water pollution control authority. Do not discharge effluent to the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Do not use, pour, spill, or store near heat or open flame.

Remove pets and children from area. Do not apply when other persons are in the immediate area. Do not allow children or pets in area until surfaces are dry. Do not apply directly to clothing, rubber, and plastic materials because damage may occur. Care should be taken to avoid spotting of walls and furniture. ROACHES, ANTS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, CRICKETS: Spray heavily into all cracks, around baseboards, beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, etc. Spray other localized areas infested with these pests. Repeat application as necessary. BROWN DOG TICKS: Thoroughly spray sleeping quarters of animals. Spray infested areas around animals should be repeated as necessary. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment.

WASPS and FLYING MOTHS OUTDOORS: For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages, etc. CHIGGERS, ANTS OUTDOORS: For treatment of localized infestations of these insects in outdoor areas, spray directly on infested areas. Avoid spraying desirable plants. For ants, thoroughly wet hills and runways. Repeat applications as infestation persists.
