You have updated your "If Swallowed" statement of practical treatment to read "Harmful if swallowed"; however, you should add the language "Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician."

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash hands after using. Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs with this spray. Do not allow spray to contact food, feedstuffs, or supplies. Thoroughly wash food contact surfaces with soap and water if they become contaminated by application of this product. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Remove pets and cover fish bowls (tanks) before spraying. Do not use this product in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially processed or prepared. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.
STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: IF SWALLOWED: Harmful if swallowed. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. IF IN EYES OR ON SKIN: Flush with plenty of water. FOR EYES: Get medical attention. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Cholinesterase is a cholinesterase inhibitor. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition appear, atropine only by injection is an antidote.

Authorized by USDA for use in inedible product areas of federally inspected meat and poultry plants. For use in non-food areas indoors and outside premises of hotels, motels, homes, residences, apartment buildings, commercial, office, institutional and storage buildings, recreational buildings, boats, ship cabins and hospitals. In Hospitals: Remove patients prior to treatment. Ventilate rooms for two hours before returning patients. This product can be used in non-food areas only, such as corridors, offices, loyers, lavatories, garages, utility rooms, storage rooms, and basements of packaging and processing plants, milk handling areas of milk plants, milk storage rooms, egg processing plants, supermarkets, restaurants, fooding plants, canneries, flour and feed mills; and bakeries. Also for use in and around campers, mobile homes, buses and automobiles. This product can be used in cargo planes, trucks, boxcars and ship cargo holds only if the vehicles are not used for transport of food or food products at any time. Also for use in dog kennels, and horse stables. Do not spray on horses and dogs. Do not spray dog and horse food or feed items.

One gallon of spray is sufficient to treat 1500 linear feet with a 6 inch spray. For contact and residual sprays, use product without diluting. For repeat applications, dilute with equal parts of water.

CONTACT SPRAY: Kills and reduces infestations: Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Carpet Beetles, Clover Mites, Centipedes, Millipedes, Firebrats, Earwigs, Sowbugs, Ants, Fire Ants, Spiders, Fleas: Use as a spot treatment. When possible, spray directly on pests to reduce infestations. Apply as a coarse spray or with a paint brush into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes

and sinks; under refrigerator and other appliance; baseboards and storage areas. Apply spray until area is wet, but not to the point of run-off. Repeat if necessary. Apply To Kill Ants, Spiders, Fleas and points of entry within buildings and homes. Spray directly on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary. To Control Fire Ants: Dilute 1:5 plus (0.7L) of this product in 1 gallon (3.8L) water. Apply 1 gal. (3.8L) of solution as a gentle rain to each fire ant mound, using sprayer can. Thoroughly wet the mound and surrounding area to a 4 foot diameter (1.2m). For best results, apply in cool weather, or in early morning or late evening hours. Treat new mounds as they appear. Do not disturb the mound prior to treatment. If possible, treat all mounds in the vicinity and treat all colonies which may not as yet have constructed a mound. Fleas, Brown Dog and Lone Star Ticks: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet's beds and resting quarters; heavy cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards; windows and door frames where these pests may be present. Clear bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. Do not treat pets with this product. Treat pets with a product registered for animal application to control the source of flea and tick infestation. Carpet Beetles: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment along baseboards and edges of carpeting, under carpeting, rugs and furniture, in closets and on shelving, and wherever else these insects are seen or suspected. ATTENTION: (Pests indoors) Do not apply this water-based product in conduits, motor housings, junction and switch boxes or other electrical equipment because of possible shock hazard. If there is need to treat such areas, use only of base sprays. Prior to application, de-energize electrical equipment. After application allow time for oil to evaporate before starting motors or placing switches in the "ON" position. RESIDUAL SPRAY: Aids in the control of Fire Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Centipedes, Millipedes, Earwigs, Sowbugs: Kills up to 4 weeks. Apply on baseboards, cracks and crevices around door window frames, and other hiding places such as closets, in back of and under appliances, sinks and cupboards in kitchens and bathrooms. In basements, apply in hiding places in cracks and crevices, lower walls and dark places. Apply as a wet spray in a 6 inch band until area is thoroughly wet but not to the point of run-off. Treat on a monthly basis or as necessary. PEST OUT-OF-DOORS: GENERAL INFORMATION: Use product for control of certain pests on the outside surfaces of buildings. Consult the following directions for dosage and application details to control the pests listed. PESTS ON OUTSIDE SURFACES OF BUILDINGS: Use this product to control ants, clover mites, crickets, earwigs, millipedes, and sowbugs by application as a residual spray with a paint brush to outside surfaces of buildings, including porches, screens, window frames, eaves, patios, garages, refuse dumps, other areas where these pests congregate or have been seen. Do not treat or allow the spray to contact plants (lawns, flowerplants, shrubs, trees, evergreens, etc.) because of possible injury. Repeat treatment as needed to maintain effectiveness. Note: To help prevent infestation of buildings by ants, crickets, and sowbugs (pillbugs), treat a band of soil 6 to 10 feet wide and adjacent to the buildings, also the building foundation to a height of 2 to 3 feet where pests are active and may find entrance. Use 7.7 ounces of product per gallon of water and apply as a coarse spray at the rate of about 1 gallon per 100 sq. ft. to thoroughly and uniformly wet the band.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal. STORAGE: Do not store at temperatures below 32°F. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
