The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, changing the declaration of petroleum distillates from active to inert and revising the physical hazard statement on the label, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Add the statement "Do not puncture or incinerate" to the container disposal statement.
2. Add a footnote to the label ingredient statement indicating "Contains petroleum distillates."
3. The declaration of the active ingredient d-phenothrin in the ingredient statement must be changed to:

3-phenoxybenzyl-(1RS, 3RS, 1RS, 3RS)-2,2-
dimethyl-3-(2-methylprop-1-enyl)cyclopro-
panecarboxylate

Note that all isomer are combined in to one percentage.

4. PR Notice 87-8 has been withdrawn. You may wish to revert back to the physical hazard statements used prior to PR Notice 87-8.

STORAGE and DISPOSAL

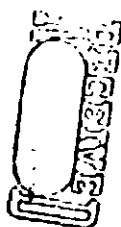
Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame

To Kill Fleas-Larvae and Adults: Remove and destroy old pet bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, windows and door frames, wall cracks and floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. Also treat dogs and cats with registered flea control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

To treat carpets: spray at the rate of 3 square ft per second. Repeat treatment as necessary.
