
1) Since this product contains petroleum distillates, change the First Aid Statement for If Swallowed to read:

- IF SWALLOWED:\*
- \* Immediately call a poison control center or doctor.
  - \* Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor.
  - \* Do not give **any** liquid to the person.
  - \* Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Submit two copies of the finished label before the product is released for shipment under this revised label.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin. In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water. Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice. IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Contains petroleum distillates - vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS: EXTREMELY FLAMMABLE. Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: STORAGE: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame. CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! IF EMPTY: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. IF PARTLY FILLED: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. HOLD UP SIDE DOWN TO SPRAY

TO KILL FLEAS (Larvae and Adults): Remove and destroy old pet bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, windows and door frames, wall cracks and floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered fleas control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

TO TREAT CARPETS: Spray at the rate of 3 square ft. per second. Repeat treatment as necessary.
