The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. The "Physical Or Chemical Hazards" statement appears to refer to a fogger type product. Remove the following phrases as they contradict the use directions for this product:

"Turn off pilot lights in gas appliances and unplug or turn off electrical equipment in the use area. After airing out phase is completed, relight pilot lights and reconnect electrical current. Do not smoke in the use area."

2. To avoid confusion with the use direction precautions, revise the statement "Do not allow children to rub eyes if hands have been treated." to read:

Do not allow children to rub eyes with hands after contact with treated areas.

3. Place the following misuse statement directly following the heading "Directions For Use":

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS—CAUTION.** Keep out of reach of children. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes and lips. In case of contact, immediately flush area of contact with plenty of water. If irritation persists or the product is ingested, get medical attention. Do not apply near food or livestock. Do not allow children to rub eyes if hands have been treated. Use sparingly on small children.

Incineration of container may cause explosion. Avoid contact with plastics such as eyeglass frames and such fabrics as acetate and rayon.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE: READ ALL DIRECTIONS BEFORE USING THIS PRODUCT.** Do not spray in enclosed areas. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply to eyes and mouth and do not apply to the hands of young children. Do not spray directly on face. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid overexposure. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you.

Remove protective cap. Hold can at least 12 inches away, point valve in desired direction and press button to spray. To apply to face, spray on hands and rub on. For ticks and chiggers, also spray shoe tops, socks and around openings of clothing. It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Storage—Store in a cool dry place away from heat and open flame. Disposal—Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection. Do not puncture or incinerate container. 1/92
