PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes and lips. In case of contact, immediately flush area of contact with plenty of water. If irritation persists or the product is ingested, get medical attention. Do not apply near food or livestock. Do not allow children to rub eyes with hands after contact with treated areas. Use sparingly on small children.

FIRST AID STATEMENTS: IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply to eyes and mouth and do not apply to the hands of young children. Do not spray directly on face. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid overexposure. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you. Remove protective cap. Hold can at least 12" away, point valve in desired direction and press button to spray. To apply to face, spray on hands and rub on. For ticks and chiggers, also spray shoe tops, socks and around openings in clothing.

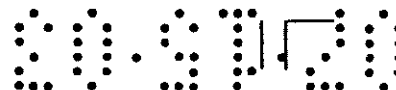
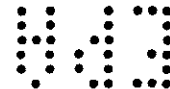
