Dear Mr. Padovani;

The Agency in accordance with the Federal Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as Amended (FIFRA) has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the aforementioned product in connection the **MGK 326 RED**, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable with the following label revision provisions:

1. Within the ingredient statement, revise the statement "Inert Ingredients" to "Other Ingredients"
2. Per the Acute Toxicology review, revise in all locations, the signal word from CAUTION to "WARNING".
3. Revise the statements within the section entitled "HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS" as follows:
"WARNING: Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove and wash clothing before reuse.

Within the **FIRST AID** section, remove the word "**SKIN:**" immediately before the statement "If you suspect a reaction to this product: Discontinue use. Rinse skin..... Treatment advice."

4. Directions for Use:
 - a. Place the section subtitle "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" on a separate line from the FIFRA mandatory language: "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling."

Current labels on DEET repellent products tend to dissolve from contact with the repellent (usually liquids). All reregistered DEET product labels must use materials that remain permanent and readable for the reasonable life of the product. The Agency determined in the DEET RED document that all aerosol and pump spray formulations must be packaged in containers utilizing a concave trigger to help aim product or other comparable mechanism that will ensure that the product will not be inadvertently sprayed in the eyes.

The Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines for repellent products. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment

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Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for personal repellent products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.


Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance. As an alternative, you may refer consumers to the company's phone number or email address.

NOTE: This product is not being re-registered under FIFRA Sec. 4(g) at this time.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes and lips. In case of contact, immediately flush area of contact with plenty of water. If irritation persists or the product is ingested, get medical attention. Do not apply near food or livestock. Do not allow children to rub eyes with hands after contact with treated areas. Use sparingly on small children.

FIRST AID STATEMENTS: IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment. **SKIN:** If you suspect a reaction to this product: Discontinue use. Rinse skin thoroughly with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: EXTREMELY FLAMMABLE. Do not use or store near fire, sparks or heated surfaces. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Incineration of container may cause explosion. Avoid contact with plastics, such as eyeglass frames, and such fabrics as acetate and rayon.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **READ AND FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS AND PRECAUTIONS ON THIS PRODUCT LABEL.**

Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply to eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Do not allow children to handle this product, and do not apply to children's hands. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child. Do not apply more than 3 times per day to children ages twelve (12) and under. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Avoid overexposure. Do not use under clothing. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again. Do not spray directly on face. Spray hands first and then use hands to wipe spray onto face. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you.

Remove protective cap. Hold can at least 12" away, point valve in desired direction and press button to spray. To apply to face, spray on hands and rub on. For ticks and chiggers, also spray shoe tops, socks and around openings in clothing.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! **IF EMPTY:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **IF PARTLY FILLED:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
