Dear Mr. Turetsky:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following label revision provision(s):

General Comment(s):

1. Current labels on DEET repellent products tend to dissolve from contact with the repellent (usually liquids). All DEET product labels must use materials that remain permanent and readable for the reasonable life of the product.

<u>Directions for Use section comment(s)</u>:

- 2. Revise the 8th sentence to read "Avoid over-application of this product."
- Revise the 14th sentence to read "If you suspect a reaction to this product, discontinue use, wash treated skin, and call your local poison control center."
- 4. Revise the 18th sentence to read "If used on the face, spray on palm of hands first and then apply sparingly and avoid eyes. Do not spray directly onto face."

Storage and Disposal Statement section comment(s):

5. Revise the existing "STORAGE:" subsection to read "PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store this product in a cool, dry (preferably locked) place away from heat or open flame, and in an area that is inaccessible to children and animals."

Optional Marketing Statements section comment(s):

6. Revise the 2nd optional marketing statement to read "Repels Mosquitoes that may carry West Nile Virus and Cache Valley, Eastern equine, Western equine, LaCrosse, or St. Louis encephalitis."

Ingredient Statement section comment(s):

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records. Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of FIFRA. Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes accepting of these conditions.
