Dear Mr. Turetsky:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following label revision provision(s):

General Comment(s):

1. Current labels on DEET repellent products tend to dissolve from contact with the repellent (usually liquids). All DEET product labels must use materials that remain permanent and readable for the reasonable life of the product.

Directions for Use section comment(s):

2. Revise the 8th sentence to read "Avoid over-application of this product."
3. Revise the 14th sentence to read "If you suspect a reaction to this product, discontinue use, wash treated skin, and call your local poison control center."
4. Revise the 18th sentence to read "If used on the face, spray on palm of hands first and then apply sparingly and avoid eyes. Do not spray directly onto face."

Storage and Disposal Statement section comment(s):

5. Revise the existing "**STORAGE:**" subsection to read "**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Store this product in a cool, dry (preferably locked) place away from heat or open flame, and in an area that is inaccessible to children and animals."

Optional Marketing Statements section comment(s):

6. Revise the 2nd optional marketing statement to read "**Repels Mosquitoes that may carry West Nile Virus and Cache Valley, Eastern equine, Western equine, LaCrosse, or St. Louis encephalitis.**"

Ingredient Statement section comment(s):


7. Revise the first 2 lines found within the ingredient statement to read "DEET 25%"

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A copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records. Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of FIFRA. Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes accepting of these conditions.

apply to children's hands. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child. Do not apply more than 3 times per day to children ages twelve (12) and under. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Avoid overexposure. Do not use under clothing. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again. Do not spray directly on face. Spray hands first and then use hands to wipe spray onto face. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you.

Remove protective cap. Hold can at least 12" away, point valve in desired direction and press button to spray. To apply to face, spray on hands and rub on. For ticks and chiggers, also spray shoe tops, socks and around openings in clothing.
