**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid skin and eye contact. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking. **IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or Poison Control center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **IF ON SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. **IF IN EYES:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. **IF INHALED:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams and ponds. Do not contaminate water by disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on the label.

**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE**

To operate, hold can upright, direct nozzle toward the surface to be treated, and press the actuator button. Do not use as a space spray.

**TO KILL ANTS, CARPET BEETLES, CENTIPEDES, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, FIREBRATS, PILLBUGS, SILVERFISH and SPIDERS:** Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment in areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of the rooms and closets, cracks and crevices under carpets, along baseboards and door sills and frames, behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. Spray ant trails, nests and points of entry.

**TO KILL BROWN DOG TICKS:** Apply thoroughly as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters and nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not spray pets with this product.

**TO CONTROL HOUSEFLIES, GNATS, HORNETS, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS, WASPS and YELLOW JACKETS:** Use only on outdoor surfaces. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames and other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas, such as under eaves, porches, partitions and in garages where these insects congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when effectiveness diminishes.

Prior to application de-energize electrical equipment. Limit spot treatment to floor surfaces where pests have been seen or where they are suspected of hiding. Limit individual spot treatments to an area no larger than 20% of the floor surface. Any individual spot treatment must not exceed 2 square feet. Take extreme care that the product is not introduced into the air. Avoid contamination of food and food processing surface. Application Within Food Serving Areas (Facilities where foods are served, such as dining rooms but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held): Apply as a spot treatment to selected surfaces, such as baseboards, under elements of construction and into cracks and crevices.
