Your Application Dated August 1, 1987

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Add an asterisk to INERT INGREDIENTS* and a footnote "This product contains petroleum distillates."
2. Add:

Note to Physician

Diazinon is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine. Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid skin and eye contact. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Do not spray in rooms or use on plants. Apply as a surface spray only. Do not allow spray to contact food, feedstuffs or water supplies. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils contaminated with this product. Remove pets and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **IF ON SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. **IF IN EYES:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. **IF INHALED:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams and ponds. Do not contaminate water by disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on the label.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

THIS PRODUCT CONTAINS AN EXTREMELY FLAMMABLE PROPELLANT. Do not use or store near fire, stoves or heated surfaces. Turn off pilot lights in gas appliances and unplug or turn off electrical equipment in the use area. After airing out phase is completed, reinsert pilot lights and reconnect electrical current. Do not smoke in the use area. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting; incineration of container may cause explosion.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.
Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and place in trash collection.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

To operate, hold can upright, direct nozzle toward the surface to be treated and press actuator button. Do not use as a space spray.

TO KILL ANTS, CARPET BEETLES, CENTIPEDES, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, FIREBRATS, PILLBUGS, SILVERFISH and SPIDERS: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of the rooms and closets, cracks and crevices, under carpets, along baseboards and door sills and frames, behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. Spray ant trails, nests and points of entry.

TO KILL BROWN DOG TICKS: Apply thoroughly as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters and nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not spray pets with this product.

TO CONTROL HOUSEFLIES, GNATS, HORNETS, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS, WASPS and YELLOW JACKETS: Use only on outdoor surfaces. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames and other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas, such as under eaves, porches, patios and in garages where these insects congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when effectiveness diminishes.

APPLICATION OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN AS A SPOT AND/OR CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT IS NOT PERMITTED. Application within food handling establishments includes other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served, including but not limited to areas for receiving, storage, packing, scanning, bottling, wrapping, boxing, preparing foods, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edibles, oils, syrups, and serving areas) when food is exposed and facility is in operation. Use as a crack and crevice treatment in and around both food and non-food areas to control ANTS, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS and WATERBUGS.

Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floor, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment, electrical conduits, motor housings, junction or switch boxes. Prior to application, de-energize electrical equipment. Limit spot treatment to floor surfaces where pests have been seen or where they are suspected of hiding. Limit individual spot treatments to an area no larger than 2% of the floor surface. Any individual spot treatment must not exceed 2 square feet. Take extreme care that the product is not introduced into the air. Avoid contamination of food and food processing surfaces.

Application within Food serving areas (Facilities where foods are served, such as dining rooms, bars and clubs) areas where food may be prepared or held: Apply as a spot treatment to similar surfaces, such as baseboards, under elements of construction and in to cracks and crevices. Also treat all surfaces likely to be contacted by food. Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed.
