WARNING

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Do not expose product to heat, spark or open flame. Store container in a cool dry location. Do not expose product to temperature extremes. Store product in original shipping container in a cool, dry storage area. Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food or feed with storage or disposal.

Waste Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. In the event of a spill or leak, contain product with a dry absorbent and dispose of in accordance with state or local regulations. Wear protective clothing during clean up procedures.

Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or recycle and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

DESCRIPTION OF PRODUCT

This liquid weed killer is composed of 5-bromo-3-(3-butyl-6-methyluracil) (bromacil) in a phyto-toxic oil. The oil carrier combines the properties of volatility with rapid penetration and translocation in the plant. The insolubility of the herbicide in water assures full effect regardless of rainfall after application or stage of growth at the time of application.

It produces rapid top kill of all succulent vegetation. Translocation and root absorption of component herbicides produce extensive root kill of weeds and provide long term residual control.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

GENERAL WEED CONTROL: This product can be used to control most weeds for an extended period of time on non-cropland areas such as loading ramps, feed chows, railroads, storage yards, parking lots, around buildings and industrial plant sites.

Do not apply this product to areas where the roots of desirable plants such as trees or ornamentals will come into contact with it, as injury might result. Do not use on lawns, driveways, walks or similar areas. Avoid spray drift to susceptible plants, as this product may injure cotton, beans, peas, grapes, ornamentals, etc. Do not contaminate domestic water or irrigation water and keep from contact with fertilizer, insecticides, fungicides and seeds. Vapors from this product may injure susceptible plants in the vicinity. Coarse sprays are less likely to drift.

Thoroughly clean all traces of product from application equipment immediately after use. Use a suitable chemical cleaner, then wash with detergent and rinse with clear water. Do not contaminate water sources by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR USE

Any application equipment such as: Power sprayers, Compressed air hand sprayers, Knapsack sprayers or Sprinkler cans, is suitable for applying this product. Equipment should be calibrated so as to assure application of the recommended amount of material.

To control annual weeds and grasses such as Foxtail, Ryegrass, Wildoats, Crabgrass, Cheatgrass, Broomsedge, Ragweed, Lambsquarter and Turkey mullen, dilute one gallon of this product to 9 gallons of water and apply 5 gallons of the diluted spray, per 1,000 square feet.

For hard to kill perennial weeds and grasses such as Johnson grass, Salt grass, Bouncing Bet, Bracken fern, Horsetail, Smooth brooms, Canada bluegrass, Purpletop, Quackgrass, Broomsedge, Aster dandelion, Dog fennel, Goldenrod, Plantain and Wild carrot, dilute one gallon of this product to 9 gallons of water and apply 10 gallons of diluted spray per 1,000 square feet.

This concentrate may be applied at any time of the year except when the ground is frozen. Best results are obtained after predominant weeds have emerged and developed to a point where they present a problem.
