

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable, provided you make the following changes before you release the product for shipment.

1. Change IF SWALLOWED statement in First Aid to read:
"If Swallowed: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person."
2. Change subheading "Storage" to "Pesticide Storage" in STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
3. Insert phrase "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal" directly under the heading STORAGE AND DISPOSAL.
4. Add maximum application rates and times under Use Directions for spot treatment and large treatment areas.
5. Add the following text under Directions for Use:
"Applicators and other handlers must wear:
Long sleeved shirt, long pants
socks and shoes
chemical resistant gloves made of any waterproof material."
6. It is recommended that a company telephone number or toll-free hotline number is included in the First Aid section for emergencies.

Submit three (3) copies of final printed labeling incorporating the above changes before you release the product for shipment. Amended labeling will supercede all previously accepted ones. A stamped copy of labeling is enclosed for your records.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING: May be fatal if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe vapors or spray mist. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Causes eye and skin irritation. In case of contact immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Contains petroleum distillates - vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to wildlife and fish. For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

USE DIRECTIONS: A non-selective herbicide that can be applied for post-emergence or pre-emergence weed control. It is recommended that this product be used in areas such as industrial sites, around buildings, roadways, rights-of-way, lumber yards, tank farms, cemeteries, driveways, parking lots, fence areas, recreational areas and airports. Product is water emulsifiable and non-corrosive to equipment. Do not contaminate water used for domestic or irrigation purposes. Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides.

DILUTION FOR WEED and GRASS CONTROL: **SPOT TREATMENT:** For control of annual and susceptible perennial weeds (such as downy brome grass, oatgrass, goosegrass, puncture-vine, goldenrod and plantain), thoroughly mix 2-3 pints of this product in 3 gallons of water and spray up to 250 square feet to give thorough and uniform coverage.

LARGE TREATMENT AREA: Application rates for large areas depend on climatic conditions, soil type, weeds present and stage of growth of the weeds. Mix one gallon product with 10 gallons water to cover 650 to 1000 square feet. The recommended dosages are equivalent to 43-65 gallons of product per acre. The higher rate of application should be used where longer residual control is desired in regions with a long growing season or for control of hard-to-kill perennial weeds and grasses such as Johnson Grass, bindweed and wild carrot. During seasons with excessive rainfall causing heavy weed growth, repeat treatment may be required.

For faster top-kill of existing vegetation, apply this product at the above dilution rates in diesel oil, fuel oil or weed oil. This product should not be used on land to be cropped, or near desirable tree, shrubs or plants, as injury may occur. Do not apply to areas underlain by roots of desirable trees and shrubs.
