To repel the insects listed on the Front Panel, first remove protective cap. Hold can at least 12" away, point valve in desired direction and press button to spray.

Apply liberally to all exposed skin areas. To apply to face, spray on hands and rub on. Repeat as needed. For ticks and chiggers, also apply liberally to shoe tops, socks and around openings in clothing.

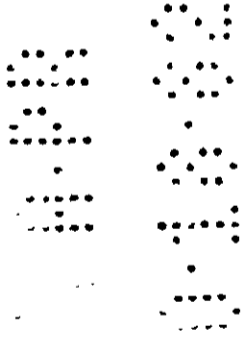
