**To kill Fire Ants in their Mounds:** DO NOT DISTURB MOUND PRIOR TO TREATMENT. Attach injector rod to can. While spraying, slowly drive rod into mound until resistance is met, which indicates the bottom of the nest has been reached. Spray for 5 seconds for each 6" diameter mound. For example, an 18" diameter mound would require three separate injections around the mound. All mounds in the vicinity should be treated. For best results treatment should be made in early morning or late evening when ants are least active.

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:**
