DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches. PLEAS (Adults and Larvae) and TICKS: Remove and thoroughly clean or destroy pet bedding. Spray pet sleeping quarters, bed, entire floor and floor covering, with special attention to cracks and crevices, around baseboards, and window and door frames. Infested upholstered furniture may also be treated with this product. A test application should be made to upholstery or drapery fabrics in an inconspicuous place before use.

This product may be used on pets. Starting at the tail, stroke against the lay of the hair, spraying the parted fur in short bursts, directly behind the hand to insure penetrating the coat. Dampen the fur up to the head. Repeat applications weekly if necessary to control infestations. NOTE: Not recommended for use on kittens or puppies less than four weeks old.

COCKROACHES, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, SPIDERS: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, killing insects with spray whenever possible. Repeat treatment if necessary.

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat if necessary.

CARPET BEETLES: Spray directly on beetles, baseboards, floors, shelves and carpets. Repeat treatment if necessary.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper. Discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS:

CAUTION: Avoid inhalation or ingestion of spray. Wash hands thoroughly after use. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

HAZARDS TO DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

Do not spray directly in/on eyes, mouth or genitals of pets. Do not treat or cause exposure to kittens or puppies less than four weeks old. When using this product other than directly on pets, remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:

IF INHALED: Remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists. IF ON SKIN: Wash affected areas immediately with soap and water.
