- d. As on Fairfield American Corporation's label (EPA Registration No. 4816-690) add directions for use for flea and ticks on premises.
 - e. Delete the claim "micro-emulsion." You may replace it with "Water-based aerosol."
 - f. Under Directions For Use qualify food with feed, for example:

"Do not use in food/feed . . ."
"Nonfood/nonfeed areas are areas . . ."
 - g. Use in food handling establishments can imply use in U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Meat and Poultry Plants. Therefore, either add the statement, "Not for Use in USDA Meat and Poultry Plants," or submit an application to USDA requesting use in these areas. If granted, you can then indicate on the label that the product can be used in these areas.
 - h. Add to Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals:
"Do not use on old, sick or debilitated animals."
 - i. Delete "kittens" from "Do not treat or cause . . ."

Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held.

In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

Nonfood areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches. Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Houseflies, Fruit Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Bees, Black Flies, Skipper Flies, Blow Flies and Small Flying Moths: Close all doors and windows and spray room at the rate of 2 to 3 seconds per 1000 cubic feet. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Palmetto Bugs, Silverfish, Fleas, Crickets, Scorpions, Spiders, Millipedes, Centipedes, Sowbugs and Pillbugs: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray when ever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

To control *Fleas, Ticks and Lice* on dogs. Starting at the tail, stroke against the lay of the hair, spraying the parted fur in short bursts, directly behind the hand to insure penetrating the coat. Dampen the fur up to the head. Repeat application weekly if necessary to control infestations. NOTE: Not recommended for use on puppies less than four weeks old.

For the Control of Garden Insects: For use on roses, dahlias, asters and other ornamentals to kill *Japanese Beetles* hit by spray, as well as *Whiteflies, Aphids, exposed Thrips, Spiders, Red Mites and Leafminers.*

May be used on plants, as well as a multi purpose spray in small gardens and for spot treatments of incipient insect infestations to prevent spreading in large garden areas.
