DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling in the home, all food processing surfaces and utensits should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use Exposed food should be covered or removed. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants. Spray ant hills for best control.
