Dear Ms. Watson:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Revise front of the label-- replace " Inert Ingredients" with the phrase "Other Ingredients".
2. Move statement beginning "For use in Apartments, Attics, Basement..." and ending " Industrial Plants, Motels, and Preschools." to the Directions for Use section.
3. You may delete the Environmental Hazards paragraph since this product is for indoor use only.
4. Under How to Use add "In the home" to the beginning of the sentence "All food processing surfacesetc."

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PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. For use in Apartments, Attics, Basements, Boats, Cabins, Campers, Closed Barns, Day Camps, Garages, Homes, Horse Stables, Household Storage Areas, Kennels, Pet Sleeping Areas, Rooms, Greenhouses, Ship Cabins, Lathhouses, Seedhouses, Washrooms, and the non-food/feed areas of Schools, Theaters, Trucks, Warehouses, Box Cars, Hospitals, Hotels, Industrial Plants, Motels, and Preschools.

FIRST AID STATEMENTS: IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish and other aquatic organisms. Do not contaminate water by disposal of wastes.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Do not place on stove or radiator. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Do not use this unit in less than 100 cubic feet. **IMPORTANT!** To avoid **FLAMMABILITY HAZARD**, use can as follows: • Only one can per room. • Do not place in cabinet or under counter or table. • Shut off electrical equipment. • Place can at least 6 feet from pilot lights. This product contains a highly flammable ingredient. It may cause a fire or explosion if not used properly. Follow the "Directions for Use" on this label very carefully.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. Nonfood areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets, and storage (after canning or bottling).

DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

One 6 ounce aerosol can treats up to 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area (a room 30' by 25' with an 8 foot ceiling). For FLEAS and TICKS: Use one 6 ounce can for every 1,500 cubic feet of room space.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat, sparks or open flame. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! **IF PARTLY FILLED:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.

HOW TO USE: Step 1: PREPARATION: Open cupboards, cabinets, trunks, and doors to area to be treated to allow maximum kill in all areas where insects can hide and breed. Close outside doors and windows and shut off fans and air conditioning to maximize killing power of fog. Remove pets, birds, and lightly cover or remove fish bowls and aquariums before spraying. Cover waxed wood floors and waxed furniture in the immediate area surrounding the fogger (Newspapers may be used.) Remove or cover exposed foods, dishes, utensils or food handling equipment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. Shut off electrical appliances. Do not place activated fogger in a cabinet or under a counter or table.

Step 2: ACTIVATION OF FOGGER: SHAKE WELL, JUST BEFORE USING. Place a section of newspaper on floor in center of room to be treated. **NOTE: Do NOT** place fogger on water-stainable surfaces. Do not place can within 6 feet of pilot lights. Turn can opening away from face and depress tab firmly with thumb until it clicks in locked position. Aiming spray away from face, set fogger on newspaper, leave room and close door. After activation, leave room or house at once. Keep area closed for 2 hours (30 minutes for flying insects) before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.
