The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the Phenothrin RED, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.



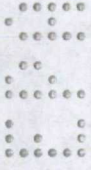

For use in Apartments, Attics, Basements, Boats, Cabins, Campers, Closed Barns, Day Camps, Garages, Homes, Horse Stables, Household Storage Areas, Kennels, Pet Sleeping Areas, Rooms, Greenhouses, Ship Cabins, Lathhouses, Seedhouses, Washrooms, and the non-food/feed areas of Schools, Theaters, Trucks, Warehouses, Box Cars, Hospitals, Hotels, Industrial Plants, Motels, and Preschools. Do not use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms.



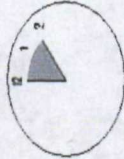
[STEP 1:] BEFORE YOU FOG: REMOVE pets, birds, and tightly cover or remove fish bowls and aquariums before spraying. Remove or cover exposed foods, dishes, utensils or food handling equipment. In the home, all food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. OPEN cabinets, cupboards, trunks, drawers, closets and doors in area to be treated to allow maximum kill in all areas where insects can hide and breed. Cover waxed wood floors, waxed furniture and other plastic surfaces near the fogger (newsprint may be used). CLOSE outside doors and windows to maximize killing power of fog. Cover or remove plants. SHUT OFF fans and air conditioners.



Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e. refrigerators, thermostats, etc). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance.



[STEP 2:] TO START FOGGING: SHAKE WELL JUST BEFORE USING. Place a section of newspaper on floor in center of room to be treated. Do NOT place fogger on water-stainable surface. Tilt can opening away from face and depress tab firmly with thumb until it clicks in locked position. Aiming spray away from face, set fogger on newspaper, leave room and close door. After activation, leave room or house at once. Vacate the treated house, individual apartment unit, or other structure immediately. Do Not Re-enter for 2 Hours. [Fill out and place hang-tag on the door to the treated area to alert family and others with access to the treated area not to enter for 2 hours.]



[STEP 3:] AIRING OUT: Wait two (2) hours after application, then open windows, vents and doors for two hours. If an odor is still detected additional ventilation is required.
