**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

Get medical attention if irritation persists. **IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. **IF INHALED:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:

The product is toxic to fish and other aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS:

Contents under pressure. Do not use near heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For Control of Hornets, and Wasps: It is preferable to apply the product in the evening after all the insects have returned to the nest. Aim valve opening at the nest and depress button, continuing to spray until the nest is soaked with the spray. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: **STORAGE:** Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame. **DISPOSAL:** Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
