**Subject: Response to Agency's August 12, 2003 Letter Concerning Label Amendment to Update First Aid Statements (PR Notice 2001-1) and Disposal Instructions (PR Notice 2001-6)**

Dear Ms. Watson:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Revise the statement "Do not use on puppies under 4 weeks" to read: "*Do not use on puppies under 12 weeks*". Domestic animal safety data are required to support use on younger animals.
2. Considering label space restrictions we recommend you add the word "*medicated*" to the first statement beginning "Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated...etc.", allowing deletion of the last two sentences regarding medication.
3. Since there are more than just pet uses on the label we recommend you move the statement "Read entire label before each use" to the front panel.
