FIRE ANT INJECTOR SPRAY

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For outdoor use only. For use in yards, parks, woodlands, playgrounds, and golf courses.

To kill Fire Ants in their Mounds; DO NOT DISTURB MOUND PRIOR TO TREATMENT. Attach injector rod to can. While spraying, slowly drive rod into mound until resistance is met, which indicates the bottom of the nest has been reached. Spray for 5 seconds for each 6" diameter mound. For example, an 18" diameter mound would require three separate injections around the mound. All mounds in the vicinity should be treated. For best results treatment should be made in early morning or late evening when ants are least active.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing of spray mist. May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: IF SWALLOWED:

Call a doctor or get medical attention. Do not induce vomiting. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Avoid alcohol. IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.
