On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c) (7) (A), provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c) (5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the following label change:

- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration Number 10807-193" to the label.
- b. Under the Environmental Hazards statements, delete the second sentence and replace it with "Do not apply directly to water."
- c. Under the section Important, replace the proposed statements with the following:

Do not use more than one fogger per room. Do not use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft.0.

or smaller; instead, allow a fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valve), other open flames or running electrical applications that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance.

- d. Delete the following statements from the labeling:

Do not use this unit in less than 100 cubic feet. (front panel)

Shut off all electrical appliances. Do not place activated fogger in a ...etc. Do not use fogger in an area less than 100 cubic feet. (side panel)

- e. Either delete greenhouses or qualify as non-commercial i.e., "greenhouses (non-commercial).

- f. Identify in the product name that the pesticide is a total release fogger i.e., "Misty Fog Off Total Release Fogger".

- g. Move the statement "One 6 ounce aerosol can treats up to 6000 cubic feet..." to the front panel preferably under the product name.

3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

This product is toxic to fish. For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

Physical or Chemical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Do not place on stove or radiator. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Do not use this unit in an area less than 100 cubic feet.

IMPORTANT! To avoid FLAMMABILITY HAZARD, use can as follows:

- + Only one can per room.
- + Do not place in cabinet or under counter table.
- + Shut off electrical equipment.
- + Place can at least 6 feet from pilot lights.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. Commercial food/feed areas where the product cannot be used include areas for receiving, serving, storage, (dry, cold, frozen, raw), packaging (cleaning, slicing,

cooking, grinding), edible waste storage, enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups).

Nonfood areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

Not for use in USDA meat and poultry plants.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat, sparks or open flame.

Disposal: Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

One 6 ounce aerosol can treats up to 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area (a room 30' x 25' with a 8 foot ceiling).

HOW TO USE:

Step 1: PREPARATION

Open cupboards, cabinets, trunks, and doors to area to be treated to allow maximum kill in all areas where insects can hide and breed. Close outside doors and windows and shut off fans and air conditioning to maximize killing power of fog. Remove poultry before treating poultry houses. Remove pets, birds, and tightly cover or remove fish bowls and aquariums before spraying. Cover waxed wood floors and waxed furniture in the immediate area surrounding the fogger.

(Newspapers may be used.) Remove or cover exposed foods, dishes, utensils, or food handling equipment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. Shut off all electrical appliances. Do not place activated fogger in a cabinet or under a counter or table. Do not use fogger in an area less than 100 cubic feet.

Step 2: ACTIVATION OF FOGGER

SHAKE WELL JUST BEFORE USING. Place a section of newspaper on floor in center of room to be treated.

NOTE: Do NOT place fogger on water-stainable surface. Do not place can within 6 feet of pilot lights.

Tilt can opening away from face, set fogger on newspaper, leave room and close door. After activation, leave room or house at once. Keep area closed for 2 hours (30 minutes for flying insects) before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.
