The Agency in accordance with the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) as amended has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the permethrin tetramethrin and piperonyl butoxide (PBO) REDs and has concluded that your submission is acceptable

NOTE This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time



ing foundations all outdoor applications to imperious surfaces such as sidewalks, patios, porches and structural surfaces (such as windows, doors, and eaves) are limited to spot or crack and crevice applications only. Do not water the treated area to the point of runoff. Not for broadcast use on outdoor residential surfaces. Application is prohibited directly to webs, drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewer storm drain water bodies or aquatic habitat can occur. (Remove protective cap.) Hold can upright and point spray opening toward nest within 2 feet of your back. Spray until nest is thoroughly saturated to kill the entire population. Residual action will kill wasps and hornets returning to the nest. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest. To kill wasps, hornets, and yellow jackets under eaves, screens, window frames, doors, patios, cracks, holes, or crevices where insects are nesting, spray for about 1-2 seconds or until surfaces are moist. To prevent entrance of insects to the house, spray around points where insects enter, such as outside plumbing faucets, etc., and cracks and crevices in foundation as well as along sills and ledges.

**CRAWLING INSECTS OUTDOORS** Do not spray nozzle away from face. Hold can on slight downward angle. For best results, spray when air is calm. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing. **PESTS ON OUTSIDE SURFACES OF BUILDINGS** For control of building infestation due to ANTS, CLOVER MITES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, MILLIPEDES, and SOWBUGS (PILIBUGS). Spray foundation of building where insects are active and may find entrance up to a height of 2 to 3 feet. Apply as a residual spray to outside surfaces of buildings where insects tend to congregate. Spray areas include (but are not limited to): screens, window frames, eaves, porches, patios, garages, and refuse dumps. **CRAWLING INSECTS ANTS COCKROACHES (including ASIAN COCKROACHES) CRICKETS CENTIPEDES AND SILVERFISH** Spray infested surface or patio or porch area, hitting as many insects as possible. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants. Spray ant hills for best control. **ANTS LONE STAR TICKS DOG TICKS CRICKETS FLEAS AND EARWIGS** Apply thoroughly to nests and around ant trails and hills.
