Dear Ms. Watson:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below.

1. Because your product contains petroleum distillates, please revise the "IF SWALLOWED" section of your "First Aid" statements to read: "Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or a doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person."
2. Based on the toxicity profile for this product you do not need to list an If on Skin or Clothing or If Inhaled first aid statement. You may delete these statements from the labeling.
3. Move the following statements from the "Precautionary Statements" section to the "Directions for Use" section of your label: "Do not use in ...poultry plants." Change "USDA" to "Federally Inspected" and revise the end of the statement to read "... commercially prepared, processed, stored or served."
4. Under the "Directions for Use" section of the label, insert the phrase "but not to the point of runoff" after the phrase "...thoroughly saturated" and "...surfaces are moist."

- 5. Add the following statements to the "Directions for Use" section: "Do not allow children and pets to enter areas until surfaces are dry. Do not attempt to spray flying insects."

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Contains petroleum distillates - vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

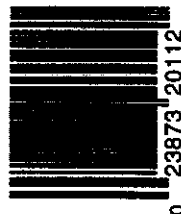
For best results, spray in early morning or late evening when insect activity is minimal. Stand a safe distance from nest and not directly underneath. (Remove protective cap.) Hold can upright and point spray opening toward nest with wind at your back. Spray until nest is thoroughly saturated to kill the entire nest population. Residual action will kill wasps and hornets returning to the nest. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest.

To kill wasps, hornets and yellow jackets under eaves, screens, window frames, doors, patios, cracks, holes or crevices wherever insects are noticed, spray for about 1-2 seconds or until surfaces are moist. To prevent entrance of insects into the house, spray around points where insects enter such as outside plumbing, faucets, etc., and cracks or crevices in foundation as well as a long sills and ledges.

Do not apply to pets or contaminate feed, foodstuff, dishes or utensils. Avoid spraying vegetation directly.
