Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food/feed should be covered or removed. Nonfood/feed areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). Vacate treated areas and ventilate before reoccupying. For maximum effectiveness, a combination of spot, surface treatment and fogging is recommended. Do not apply to classrooms while in use. 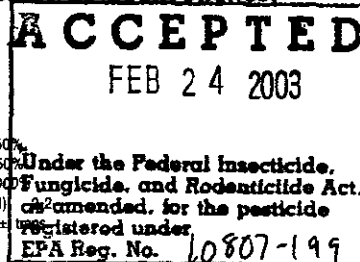

Apply spray liberally to empty chests, cracks, joints and crevices. After airing, three feet from fabric to avoid staining. To test for possible staining or discoloration, including mattresses and furniture that articles to dry thoroughly before use. **SPACE SPRAYING:** Close doors and machine adjusted to deliver a fine mist of *Mosquitoes, Slipper Flies, Wasps, Mediterranean Flour Moths, Indian Meal* angel, distributing it uniformly throughout.
