The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Permethrin Interim Decision and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. User should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet.

User should remove clothing/PPE immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This pesticide is extremely toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and invertebrates. To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters or surface waters. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is not predicted for the next 24 hours will help to ensure that wind or rain does not blow or wash pesticide off the treatment area. Rinsing application equipment over the treated area will help avoid run off to water bodies or drainage systems.

This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds while bees are foraging the treatment area.

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All outdoor spray applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:

- 1. Application to pervious surfaces such as soil, lawn, turf, and other vegetation;
- 2. Perimeter band treatments of 7 feet wide or less from the base of a man-made structure to pervious surfaces (e.g., soil, mulch, or lawn);
- 3. Applications to underside of eaves, soffits, doors, or windows permanently protected from rainfall by a covering, overhang, awning, or other structure;
- 4. Applications around potential exterior pest entry points into man-made structures such as doorways and windows, when limited to a band not to exceed one inch;
- 5. Applications to vertical surfaces (such as the side of a man-made structure) directly above impervious surfaces (e.g., driveways, sidewalks, etc.), up to 2 feet above ground level;
- 6. Applications to vertical surfaces directly above pervious surfaces, such as soil, lawn, turf, mulch or other vegetation) only if the pervious surface does not drain into ditches, storm drains, gutters, or surface waters.

Spot treatments must not exceed two square feet in size (for example, 2ft. by 1 ft or 4 ft by 0.5 ft.).

For soil or foliar applications, do not apply by ground within 25 feet of lakes, reservoirs, rivers, permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds, estuaries and commercial fish farm ponds.

Do not spray the product into fish pools, ponds, streams, or lakes. Do not apply directly to sewers or storm drains, or to any area like a drain or gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur.

Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application. Do not apply directly to impervious horizontal surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, and patios except as a spot or crack-and-crevice treatment.

Do not apply or irrigate to the point of runoff. Do not make applications during rain. Avoid making applications when rainfall is expected before the product has sufficient time to dry (minimum 4 hours).

Rainfall within 24 hours after application may cause unintended runoff of pesticide application. Do not apply when the wind speed is greater than 15 mph.

To treat insects harbored in voids and cracks-and-crevices, applications must be made in such a manner to limit dripping and avoid runoff onto untreated structural surfaces and plants.

Application of product on pets must only be done indoors. Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. In the home, cover all food processing surfaces and utensils during treatment or thoroughly wash before use. Cover or remove exposed

food/feed. Nonfood/feed areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). Vacate treated areas and ventilate before reoccupying. For maximum effectiveness, a combination of spot, surface treatment and fogging is recommended. Do not apply to classrooms while in use. Do not apply this product in occupied patient rooms or in any rooms/areas while occupied by patients, the elderly or infirm. Do not apply to institutions (including libraries, sports facilities, etc.,) in the immediate area when occupants are present. Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter until sprays have dried. Do not apply directly to sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storms drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur, except as directed by this label. Do not use in aircraft. Not for use on plants being grown for sale or other commercial use, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes. For use on plants intended for aesthetic purposes or climatic modification and being grown in ornamental gardens or parks, or on golf courses or lawns and grounds. Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs. Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquaria before space spraying or surface applications. Do not use on humans. Vacate room after treatment and ventilate before reoccupying. Except when applying to dogs or livestock, do not enter or allow others to enter until sprays have dried

All outdoor applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only except for the following permitted uses:

- 1) Treatment to soil or vegetation around structures;
- 2) Applications to lawns, turf, and other vegetation;
- 3) Application to building foundations, up to a maximum height of 3 feet;

Other than application to building foundations, all outdoor applications to impervious surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, patios, porches and structural surfaces (such as windows, doors and eaves) are limited to spot and crack-and-crevice applications, only.

Do not water the treated area to the point of run-off. Do not make applications during rain.

Do not apply as a broadcast treatment to indoor surfaces at residential sites, including nurseries, day care centers, schools, hospitals, and nursing homes. Not for use in outdoor residential misting systems.

#### **INDOOR APPLICATION:**

SURFACE SPRAYING: For 60-Day (Two Months) control Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Palmetto Bugs, Scorpions, Millipedes, Centipedes, Sowbugs, Pillbugs, Ants, Silverfish, Firebrats, Spiders, Crickets, Clover Mites, Cheese Mites, Granary Weevils, Rice Weevils, Confused Flour Beetles, Rust Red Flour Beetles, Drugstore Beetles, Meal Worms, Grain Mites and Cadelles; Direct the spray into hiding places. cracks and crevices, and behind shelves and drawers. For silverfish, spray bookcases. For ants, spray trails, nest and points of entry. To control Carpet Beetles: Spray edges of carpeting and under carpeting and rugs. Make localized application to floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks, crevices and infested areas of shelving. To control Bedbugs: Spray mattresses lightly, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray in all joints. Treat baseboards, molding and floors. To control Fleas (adult and larvae) and Ticks, including Ticks which may carry Lyme Disease (adults and larvae): As a spot treatment, thoroughly spray infested areas, pet beds, resting quarters, and entire area of floor and floor covering. Spray nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, moldings, window and door frames. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Allow to dry thoroughly before allowing pets to contact treated areas. To control Clothes Moths: Remove any infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storages directing the spray into cracks, joints and crevices. After airing, infested articles may be treated lightly, keeping nozzle at least three feet from fabric to avoid staining. To kill Lice and Louse Eggs: Spray in an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect again after drying, then proceed to spray entire area to be treated. Spray from a distance of 8 to 10 inches. Treat only those garments and parts of bedding, including mattresses and furniture that cannot be either laundered or dry cleaned. Allow all treated articles to dry thoroughly before use.

**SPACE SPRAYING:** Close doors and windows and shut off ventilating systems. Apply with a good machine adjusted to deliver a fine mist or fog. *For rapid control of House Flies, Fruits Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes, Skipper Flies, Wasps, Hornets, Bees, Black Flies, Angoumois Grain Moths, Mediterrean Flour Moths, <i>Indian Meal Moths and Tobacco Moths:* Direct spray at an upward angle, distributing it uniformly throughout the entire area at a rate of 1 ounce per 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for 2 hours. Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter until vapors, mists have dispersed, and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated. **FOGGING:** *To kill exposed or accessible stages of listed named crawling insects:* Use a rate of 1 gallon to

20,000 to 40,000 cubic feet for space. Contact insects directly when possible. Keep area closed for 2 hours. Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter until vapors, mists have dispersed, and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated.

ON LIVESTOCK: To protect cattle (beef and dairy), goats, sheep, hogs and horses from Horn Flies, Face Flies, House Flies, Mosquitoes and Gnats: Apply a light mist sufficient to wet the surface of the hair. For face flies, spray face and head, but do not spray into eyes. To control Stable Flies, Horse Flies and Deer Flies:

Apply at a rate of 2 ounces per adult animal, sufficient to wet the hair thoroughly. **To control Blood-Sucking Lice:** Apply to the infested areas of the animal, using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. **To control Poultry Lice:** Spray roosts, walls and nests or cages thoroughly. This should be followed by spraying over the birds with a fine mist. **To control Bedbugs and Mites in poultry houses:** Spray crevices of roost poles, cracks in walls, and cracks in nests where the bedbugs and mites hide.

**ON DOGS:** Consult a veterinarian before using this product on medicated, debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals. Do not use on dogs under 12 weeks. Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately. **To control Fleas, Ticks and Lice:** Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure that the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and underbody. While spraying, fluff the hair so that the spray will penetrate to the skin. Make sure spray wets thoroughly, but do not saturate animal. Do not spray into eyes or face. Avoid contact with genitalia. Use protective gloves or mitts when applying product. DO NOT USE ON CATS OR KITTENS. **May be toxic or potentially fatal if applied to or ingested by cats.** Accidental application to cats and/or grooming a recently treated dog may result in tremors and/or uncoordinated muscle movements. If this occurs, immediate veterinary care should be provided.

#### **OUTDOOR APPLICATION:**

To control Ticks, including Ticks which may carry Lyme Disease (perimeter treatment): Use this product as a residual treatment to control Ticks including the Deer Tick (Ixodes dammini), Lone Star Tick (Amblyomma americanum), Brown Dog Tick (Rhipicephalus sanguineus), American Dog Tick (Dermacentor variabilis) and Western Black-legged Tick (Ixodes pacificus): For each areas listed below, apply until surface is wet but not to the point of runoff (approximately 1 gal/750-1000 square feet). Treat around windows and doors, porches, screens, eaves, patios, garages, under stairways and in crawl spaces where these pest may enter. Treat a band of vegetation and leaf litter 6 to 10 feet wide around the outside of buildings to help control ticks occurring there. To help control ticks in outdoor activity areas, treat a band of vegetation and leaf litter 6-10 feet wide and adjacent to activity areas, especially where dense vegetation occurs. For control of Garden Insects: For use on roses, dahlias, asters and other ornamentals to kill Japanese Beetles hit by the spray as well as Whiteflies, Aphids, Exposed Thrips, Spiders, Red Mites and Leafminers: May be used on plants as a multi-purpose spray in small gardens and for spot treatments of incipient insect infestations to prevent spreading in large garden areas. May also be used on other plants such as African violets, asters, azaleas, begonias, camellias, carnations, chrysanthemums, dahlias, delphiniums, dogwoods, English ivy, eunonymus, faschia, geraniums, crassula, grape vines. Kentia palms, laurels, marigolds, rhododendrons, roses, rubber plants, snapdragons, stocks, wandering jews and zinnias. Effective when used as directed against Whiteflies, Aphids, Spider and Red Mites, Exposed Thrips, Lace Bugs, Japanese Beetles, Pavement Ants, Clover Mites and Armyworms: When spraying plants, do not operate closer than 18 inches. Use sweeping motion. Be cautious about wetting tender foliage, young plants and new growth. Do not spray plants when temperatures exceed 90°F. Contact insects directly whenever possible.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. PESTICIDE STORAGE AND SPILL PROCEDURES: Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. CONTAINER HANDLING: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Clean container promptly after emptying. For 5 gallon [or less] containers: Triple Rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container ¼ full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times. For containers larger than 5 gallons: Triple Rinse as follows: Empty remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 10 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto it other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.

Do not pour or dispose down-the-drain or sewer. Call your local solid waste Agency for lock disposal options.
