

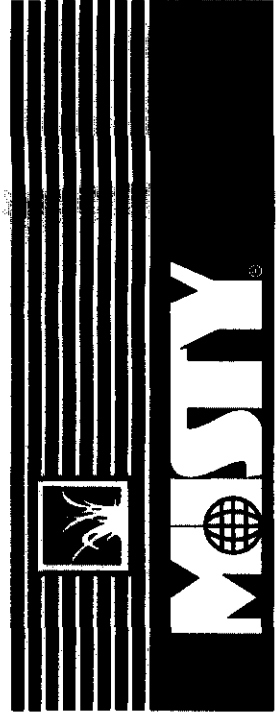

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:
WARNING: Causes skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin or inhaled. Do not get on skin or clothing. Avoid contact with eyes. Avoid breathing spray mist.

ENTRY RESTRICTIONS: For 4 days following application to non-crop areas (other than aquatic or residential sites), do not allow employees to have contact with treated plants, except for contact with their footwear. Do not allow people or pets to touch treated plants until the spray has dried. Do not use the treated water for animal treatment. Do not apply under conditions involving possible drift to food, forage or other plantings that might be damaged or the crops thereof rendered unfit for sale, use or consumption. APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS (Site Specific):
NON-CROP OR NON-PLANTED AREA USES: To kill above ground weeds grow around buildings and other installations, ornamental gardens, lawns, patios, lawns, greenhouses, benches, tennis courts, golf courses, parking lots and driveways (except for undesirable broadleaved and grassy weeds - 1 gal. per 20 gal. of water) (2 oz. per gal. water). Apply for full coverage and thorough weed control. Apply preferably to young growth and up to seeding of weeds. Repeat applications necessary to maintain control, particularly on grasses and established weeds. Avoid spray contact with foliage or food crops or ornamental plants. Do not water treated areas for 24 to 48 hours after application.

AQUATIC USE DIRECTIONS: For application only to still water (i.e., ponds, lakes, animal consumption, spraying, irrigation, or domestic purposes for 5 days after treatment). Treatment of dense weed areas can result in oxygen loss from decomposition of the weeds. This loss may cause fish suffocation. Therefore, treat only 1/2 of the water body area at one time, especially if dense areas of weeds and/or algae exist, and wait 14 days between treatments. Consult your State Fish and Game Agencies before applying this product to public waters. DO NOT APPLY TO MUDDY WATER. An oxygen rich muddy water during application. Do not apply under conditions of high wind or heavy rain. Do not apply when plants are covered with frost deposits.

APPLICATION FOR SUBMERGED WEEDS: In early season when submerged weed growth has not reached the surface apply this product by pouring directly from container into the water while moving slowly over the water surface to avoid splashing over or refilling areas in drift. 40 feet apart. In mixed weed populations, use high rate of application as indicated by weeds present. In late season or where submerged weed growth has reached the water surface throughout the area to be treated apply this product by pouring at above or repeat dilution (10:20 to 1) solution below the water surface in strips to more than 20 feet apart. Use the high rate of application as indicated by the weeds present. Where algae are present along with the submerged weeds, pre-treatment with Copper Sulfate recommended rates is advised for best results with this product.
