Subject: Labeling Amendments - Maximum Application Rate
Misty weed-A-Cide Concentrate
EPA Reg. No. 10807-146
Misty weed-A-Cide CF
EPA Reg. No. 10807-206
Your submission dated March 6, 2007

The labeling, referred to above, submitted in connection with the application under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the following changes:

1. Under "Environmental Hazards";
Add "or rinsate" after "washwaters."
2. Under "General Information";
 - Remove "such as" and provide specific locations that these products control.
 - Add the following spray drift control statement:

"Do not allow spray to drift from the application site and contact people, structures people occupy at any time and the associated property, parks and recreation areas, nontarget crops, aquatic and wetland areas, woodlands, pastures, rangelands, or animals. Apply only when wind speed is not more than 10 mph. For sprays, apply largest size droplets possible."
3. Under "Directions for Use";
 - Specify that the annual maximum application rate is 0.23 lb prometon per 500 sq. ft. or 20.04 lbs prometon per acre.
 - For Weed-A-Cide Concentrate, the application rate at 7 pints per 500 sq. ft. has exceeded the maximum application rate. You need to reduce this application rates accordingly. The calculations follow:

The label states that one gallon liquid contains 0.27 lb prometon. An application rate of 7 pints of product per 500 sq. ft. equals to 20.58 lbs


prometon per acre (0.27 x 7 ÷ 8 x 43560 ÷ 500).

- 6. Add Personal Protective Equipment requirements to Weed-A-Cide Concentrate.
- 7. Under "Storage and Disposal"

Change "Storage" to "Pesticide Storage" for Misty Weed-A-Cide CF.

The amended label supersedes all previously accepted labels. A stamped copy of the revised label is enclosed for your records. Please submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

CAUTION: Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes, skin or clothing. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

GENERAL INFORMATION: This emulsifiable concentrate provides effective non-selective annual and broadleaf weed control in non-cropland areas such as storage areas, pumps, machinery, fuel tanks, recreational areas, roadways, residential areas, guard rails, airports, military installations, highway medians, pipelines, lumberyards, rights-of-way, fences, railroads, and around buildings or industrial sites (such as cross connects, pedestals, transformers, vaults, buried cable closures, telephone booths, and fire plugs) where bare ground is desired. A wide variety of annual and perennial weeds and grasses are controlled in the above sites.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Uniformly spray one gallon of this product mixed in ten gallons of water over 1,200-sq. ft. of soil surface. Thoroughly wet all foliage to ensure contact action. Best results are obtained when applications are made during or soon after weed emergence while growth is active. Where vegetation is tall and dense, use one gallon of this product in ten gallons of water per 830 sq. ft. of soil surface. For control of hard to kill perennial weeds and grasses such as Johnsongrass, Bindweed, and Wild Carrot, use one gallon product per 750 sq. ft. of soil surface. Although this product has considerable activity through foliar contact, much of its activity is through the roots and therefore, adequate rainfall to move the chemical into the root zone is necessary. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or others either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in area during application. Do not enter or allow others to enter treated area until dusts have settled.

Under conditions where the rainfall is high and the growing season long, a second application may be necessary to maintain a weed-free soil surface.

Care must be taken to keep this herbicide away from desirable flowerbeds, lawns, and shrubs. Do not apply over roots of valuable trees, or woody ornamental plants. Only apply herbicide outside of the drip line of trees. Avoid spray drift to desirable plants.

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NOTICE: Variations in weather and conditions under which this product may be used could alter its performance and rate of effectiveness.
