This product contains a highly effective insecticide designed especially **FOR USE IN** automatic dispensers. The dispenser activates the metered valve every 15 minutes. Usually the effectiveness of this product will be noticeable within one hour after the Dispenser is activated. If less than 24 hour kill is required, the Dispenser should [be set to] start one hour before kill is desired and run one hour after kill is no longer needed. Keep in mind that factors such as airflow rate, size of space treated, humidity and room temperature affect insect activity and kill.
