The product chemistry data (MRID numbers 406096-01 to 406096-03) submitted on the above date have been evaluated by the Agency. A copy of the evaluation dated August 19, 1988 is enclosed. The recommendation does require that the registrant provide details of the production of crude PCNB, if it has been revised since the company's submissions of April 28, 1983 and November 7, 1985.

The revised Confidential Statement of Formula submitted on the above date is acceptable.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted.

1. Add a new statement to the "Environmental Hazard" paragraph:
"Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."
2. Although the "Net Content" may be expressed in metric units, in all cases, the net content shall be in terms of weight expressed as avoirdupois pounds and ounces and stated in the largest suitable units: i.e., "1 pound, 10 ounces."


