**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND**

**DANGER**

**PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS**

MINT-SOL 15 is effective against a wide variety of gram-positive and gram-negative bacteria.

MINT-SOL 15 is also an excellent deodorant. Use it to control odors, especially those that are bacterial in nature.

MINT-SOL 15 mixes readily with water and makes a clear, stable solution. In use dilution, it is non-corrosive and non-staining to plastic, vinyl, synthetics, enamel, tile and most common metals—has a pleasant mint odor.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL** — Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse that cannot be used should be disposed of according to procedures approved by Federal, State or Local disposal authorities.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL** — Under 30 gallon sizes: Triple rinse (or equivalent) and dispose of in an approved landfill or bury in a safe place. 30 gallon sizes and over: a) reseal containers and offer for reconditioning or b) Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling, reconditioning, or disposal in approved landfill or bury in a safe place.

**FOR CLEANING AND DEODORING TRUCKS, INDUSTRIAL GARBAGE HANDLING EQUIPMENT:** Pre-clean, in order for the disinfectant to be effective, apply a wetting solution of water.  
**FOR CLEANING OF WALLS AND CEILING AREAS:** Use 2-4 ounces of disinfectant per gallon of water. Cleaning is recommended.  
**MINT-SOL 15** may be used on most equipment.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**FOR RESTROOMS AND GENERAL DISINFECTION** of hard, non-porous surfaces (glass, metal, plastic, glazed porcelain, linoleum, tile, leather, vinyl, enamel and finished wood surfaces) on walls, floors, appliances and furnishings in schools, public rooms, offices, homes, pet quarters, and industrial areas.

**CLEANING.** Whenever practical, flush away gross soils with water. For cleaning, use 2½ to 4 ounces of MINT-SOL 15 per gallon of water. Cleaning may be accomplished with a clean mop, sponge, squeegee, wet vacuum system, or a mechanical spraying device. After cleaning, remove suspended soils with a clear water rinse, vacuum pick up or by wiping with a clean mop, sponge, squeegee or cloth.

**DISINFECTING.** Before disinfecting, preclean surfaces as directed above. Then, prepare 2½ ounces of MINT-SOL 15 per gallon of water and thoroughly wet the surfaces to be disinfected. (For disinfecting contagious disease areas, use 4 ounces per gallon of water). The disinfecting solution must contact the surface for 10 minutes for proper disinfection. If desired, the surfaces may then be rinsed with clear water or wiped with a clean damp cloth.

**FOR CLEANING AND DEODORIZING OR GARBAGE CANS, GARBAGE TRUCKS, INDUSTRIAL WASTE RECEPTACLES AND OTHER GARBAGE HANDLING EQUIPMENT.** It is especially important to preclean, in order for the disinfectant to perform properly. Then apply a wetting solution of 8 ounces of MINT-SOL 15 per gallon of water.

**FOR CLEANING OF WALLS, FLOORS AND INDUSTRIAL WORK AREAS.** Use 2-4 ounces per gallon of water. The use of rubber gloves is recommended for personnel doing continuous hand cleaning.

MINT-SOL 15 may be used through automatic floor scrubbing equipment.

MINT-SOL 15 has not been tested for effectiveness against *Mycobacterium tuberculosis* and must not be relied upon when tuberculocidal activity is intended. MINT-SOL 15 is not recommended for hospitals or nursing homes.

This product must not be used on food contact surfaces.
